- (c) Critical to all discussions to regarding the provincialisation of unfunded mandates must be the grounding of such discussions and frameworks in minimum service levels, so that the City of Cape Town can give confidence to residents of the City that the handing over of unfunded mandates will not result in the detrimental reduction of service levels and that these will be based on minimum acceptable levels.

4. DISCUSSION

A report titled “Service Level Agreement with the Western Cape Government in respect of Personal Primary Health Care Services for the 2020/21 Financial Year” served at a Special Council meeting on 30 June 2020. Resolution (c) of the report resolution SPC 17/06/20 requested that the Community Services & Health Directorate (CS&H) submits a report on the framework for the process of discussing the provision of health services by the City Health Department, with the aim of finalising a City discussion document within the next three months.

The administration has started the process to give effect to the aforementioned resolution. The directorates involved in this process include, inter alia, CS&H, Corporate Services, and Finance. A number of engagements have taken place with the relevant role players, under the auspices of the Director: Policy & Strategy within the Corporate Services Directorate. During this process a need was identified for a number of work streams to be developed to identify and outline decision criteria to be incorporated in the process of developing a framework.

To ensure that all relevant criteria and considerations are factored into this discussion document, more time is required for the submission of such document. The Executive Management Team (EMT) has been briefed with the process to be followed in finalising such document. In addition, preliminary engagements were held with the CFO, ED Corporate Services and Acting ED: CS&H to ensure that all aspects are covered and included in the document.

Before tabling the report at Council, it is important that the relevant stakeholders have been provided with sufficient time to engage with the substantive recommendations. This will require that CS&H and EMT utilise the months of October and November to facilitate these engagements and process for placing on the Council agenda for January 2021.

In addition to the Health Services discussion document, the issue of other unfunded mandates has also arisen as a topic of discussion in the Administration.

CS&H, as part of this process and to give a holistic view, has requested the support of EMT, in order to follow a similar process in respect of the Library & Information Services Department (LIS). This process is being undertaken by the same role players to ensure that Council is provided with all relevant information required for it to make an informed decision in this regard.

Council is therefore requested to consider granting an extension of time for the submission of this framework document, in order to allow the Administration sufficient time to provide Council with a complete and comprehensive document.

It is envisaged that the document and all internal administrative processes will be finalised and brought to Council's meeting in January 2021.


