3. PURPOSE

To request that the Subcouncil approach the Safety & Security Department to investigate the relocation of the City of Cape Town Neighbourhood Watch radio to a control room that is manned 24/7 to allow all neighbourhood watches to have access to the radio system. A number of the NHW within Ward 15 do not have access to the radio.


