Clause 328 of the City's current Supply Chain Management Policy approved by Council 30 May 2019 (C18/05/19) makes provision as follows:

The City Manager may ratify any minor breaches of the procurement process, by an Official or Committee acting in terms of delegated powers or duties, which are purely of a technical nature.

The City Manager is also authorised in terms of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations (Regulation 36) to dispense with the official procurement processes established by the City's Supply Chain Management Policy and to procure any required goods and services through any convenient process. Further also ratify any minor breaches of the procurement processes by an Official or Committee acting in terms of delegated powers. (Section 328 of the Supply Chain Management Policy).

The City Manager has inter alia sub-delegated the authority to ratify minor breaches of procurement processes by an Official or Committee acting in terms of delegated powers, to the Chairperson of the Bid Adjudication Committee. Subject to said person acting in consultation with the members of the committee.

For the period 01 October 2019 to 30 November 2019 a number of minor breaches were referred to the Supply Chain Management Bid Adjudication Committee for ratification and these are now herewith detailed in Annexure A to this submission.
