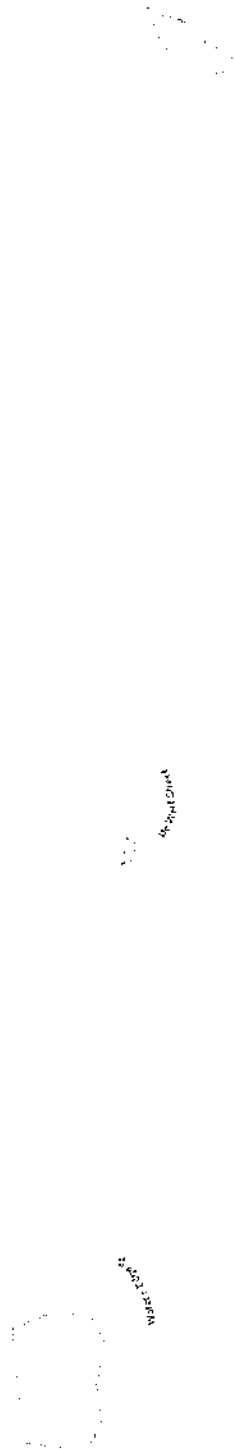

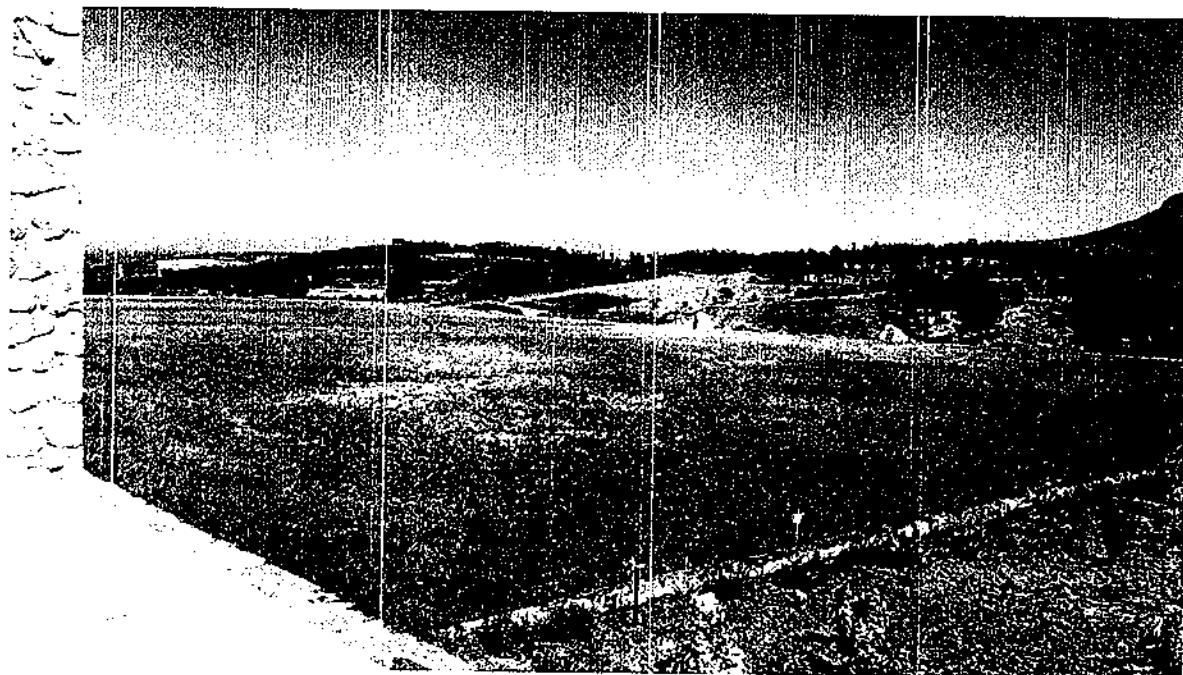

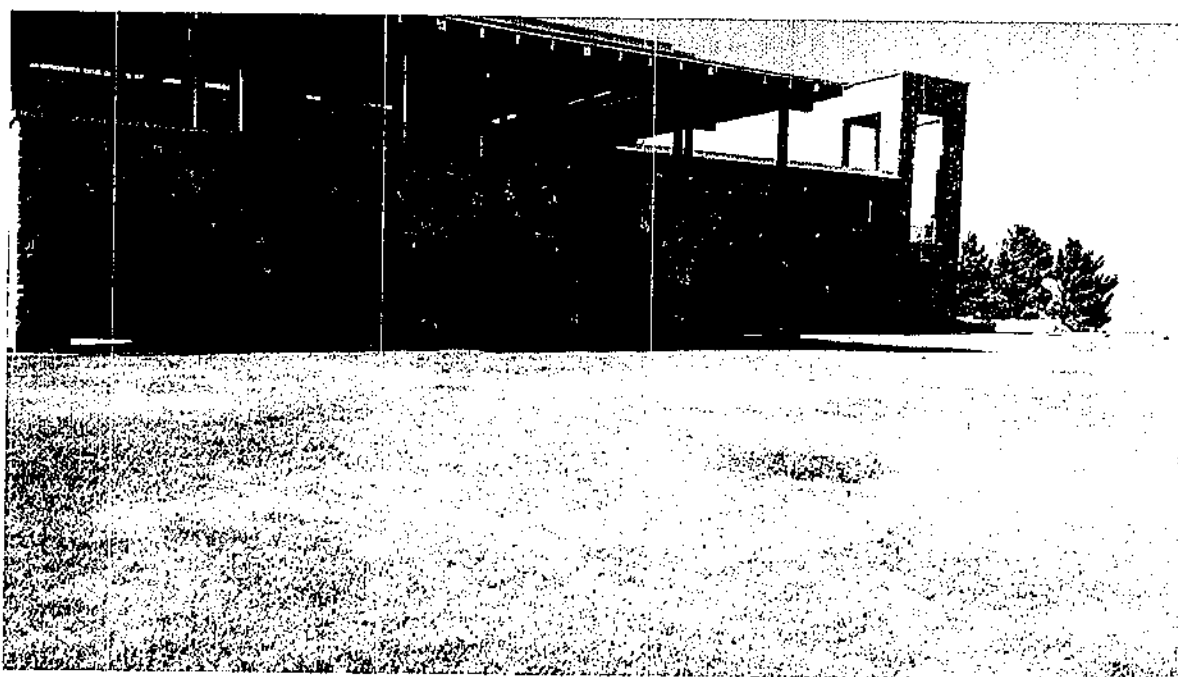
Lawn area where marquee tent will be erected

WRITTEN REPRESENTATIONS IN COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATION 19(2)(b)

SUITABILITY OF THE APPLICANT – SECTION 34(1)(b)

The Applicant will sell liquor for consumption on the premises during the event known as the Italian Festival @ Idiom 2019 that will be held on 2 & 3 March 2019 at Idiom Vineyards.

The Applicant is of good character and not disqualified from holding a license in terms of Section 35.

A signed Section 35 affidavit is annexed hereto together with a certified copy of the identity document of the Applicant. The affidavit confirms that the Applicant is not disqualified in terms of Section 35 of the Act to be the holder of a liquor license.

RIGHT OF OCCUPATION – SECTION 34(1)(d)

The Applicant's right of occupation is annexed hereto as Annexure "E".

The Applicant occupies the proposed premises with the written consent from the registered owner of the proposed premises. Written consent is provided for the duration of the event.

The Applicant however submits that Section 34(2) states that the requirement to prove the Applicant's right to occupy the premises is not applicable to a licence referred to in Section 33(2)(a), i.e. *"a licence for the sale of liquor for consumption on or off, or both on and off, the premises upon which liquor is sold at events"*.

THE PREMISES – SECTION 34(1)(c)

The premises is described as in Annexure "E".

The premises is not situated on the same erf as a filling and / or petrol station and there is no existing liquor license on the premises for which application is made.

There is an existing liquor license on the same erf, but not on the same area for which application is made.

The premises on which the sale and consumption of liquor will take place are suitable for the use by the Applicant for the purpose of the licence for which application is made.

VICINITY OF RESIDENTIAL AREAS, INSTITUTIONS FOR THE AGED OR FRAIL, EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, INSTITUTION FOR DRUG OR ALCOHOL RELATED DEPENDENCIES OR RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS – SECTION 34(1)(e)

The nearest residential area is Sir Lowry's Pass Village, situated approximately 4kms from the premises.

The nearest school is Sir Lowry's Primary School, situated approximately 4.7kms from the premises.

The nearest place of worship is the New Apostolic Church Sir Lowry's Pass, situated approximately 5kms from the premises.

The nearest institution for drug and alcohol related dependencies is the Sir Lowry's Pass Community Health Centre, situated approximately 4.5kms from the premises.

The nearest institution for the aged or frail is the Helderberg Private Nursing Home Services, situated approximately 10kms from the premises.

Prevention of negative impact on residence and institutions

The Applicant confirms that the business of the event will be carried on in such a manner that it would in no way disturb the proceedings in schools or religious institutions or prejudice the residence of a residential area, an institution for the aged or frail or an institution for drug or alcohol related dependencies.

The event is a family event with incredible exhibitions in relation to the Italian lifestyle. Various exhibitions of food, wine and even cars will be on display. Visitors will also be able to fill up their shopping bags with amongst others salami, vino and various Italian specific food.

In any event will the business be carried on in a manner that would not disturb the proceedings in schools or religious institutions or prejudice the residents of a residential area, an institution for the aged or frail or an institution for drug or alcohol related dependencies.

THE BUSINESS

The Italian Festival @ Idiom 2019 is an exhibition giving visitors to the event "A Taste of Italy in the Cape Winelands".

The event will be held at Idiom Vineyards on 2 & 3 March 2019.

The same event was held during March 2018 and February 2017 for which the Applicant successfully obtained a special event and event liquor license from the Western Cape Liquor Authority.

More about the event:

"A taste of Italy returns to the countryside of Somerset West, bigger and better than event before.

A full weekend of activities is planned on Saturday the 2nd and Sunday the 3rd of March 2019 at Idiam's spectacular Tasting Centre overlooking the Helderberg mountains and False Bay.

A festival carnival atmosphere will entertain lovers of Italian lifestyle.

Visitors will be able to enjoy food, vino, Prosecco, Italian craft beer and a live band playing Italian and other music over the weekend.

A large selection of Italian foods such as pizzas, pastas, Italian sausage and polenta will be on offer."

The Applicant wishes to sell quality liquor to visitors to the event to enjoy with their various exhibition of food that will also be on display, while enjoying the various Italian lifestyle exhibitions.

Under 18's attending the event

Under 18's will be allowed at the event, as the event may also be enjoyed by many as a family event, but no liquor will under any circumstances be sold to any person under the legal age.

The Applicant will adhere to all the applicable legislation, regulations and by-laws as the Applicant is aware that any violation of the applicable legislation, regulations and by-laws has strict penalties involved.

The Applicant has also put the following rules and regulations in place in order to prevent under 18's from purchasing and consuming liquor:

1. Identity documents must be shown at the entrance to the event.
2. Two separate colour wristbands will be given to visitors to the event, one colour for under 18's and a separate colour for over 18's.

3. Should anybody with an under 18 colour wristband be caught with liquor, they will immediately be escorted from the premises.
4. Under 18's will only be allowed to enter the event with a parent or guardian. No under 18's without any supervision will be allowed to attend the event.
5. Bar staff must also ensure that no liquor is sold to any person with an under 18 colour wristband.
6. Security staff has been allocated to patrol the festival grounds, specifically in relation to the different wristband colors.

The Applicant supports responsible drinking and will in no way tolerate any underage drinking. Any person who is caught providing liquor to minors will immediately be removed from the premises and will be reported to the local SAPS office. The Applicant is aware that providing liquor to minors is an offence in terms of the Western Cape Liquor Act 4 of 2008.

The Applicant wishes to sell all kinds of liquor to visitors to the event to enjoy with their food.

RESTRICTED AREA

In order to avoid confusion the Applicant wishes to point out that the facilities which will be provided at the event i.e. tables and chairs and the availability of food to be purchased from various vendors specifically distinguishes the Applicant's business from a bar in which liquor is served over a bar counter specifically for consumption on its own (usually at the same counter).

It is therefore respectfully submitted that the premises is not a restricted area as envisaged in the definition of "restricted area" in Section 56(2)(a) of the Western Cape Liquor Act 4 of 2008 and that the premises or any part thereof does not fall under this description.

It will create problem for visitors enjoying the event as a family if they are prevented from enjoying their food with their children because it is designated as a restricted part.

In order to avoid public embarrassment of visitors to the event the Applicant requests that it be specifically confirmed when granting the licence that the event is not a restricted area for the reasons set out above.

The Applicant however confirms that the temporary bar counter areas will be restricted areas and no under 18's will be allowed at these areas.

MANAGEMENT – SECTION 52(2)

The business under the prospective license will be managed by Bea Haumann, identity number 810924 0186 081 with residential address at 7 Sepia Street, Vermont, 7201.

It is submitted that she is of good character and not disqualified from holding a liquor license in terms of Section 35.

A signed Section 35 affidavit is annexed hereto together with a certified copy of the identity document of the Ms Haumann. The affidavit confirms that Ms Haumann is not disqualified in terms of Section 35 of the Act to be the holder of a liquor license.

The Applicant has previously successfully hosted the event during 2017 and 2018 for which events she was also the Applicant and the nominated manager.

PUBLIC INTEREST – SECTION 34(1)(a)

It is submitted that it is in the public interest that the Applicant be allowed to sell liquor of the highest quality to visitors of the event.

The Italian Festival @ Idiom 2019 event is an exhibition aiming at giving visitors to the event "A Taste of Italy in the Cape Winelands".

The Applicant wishes to make visitors', especially tourists (national as well as international), visit to the event more sophisticated and enjoyable by also being able to offer liquor of the highest quality to be enjoyed with the various food that will also be available during the event.

The Applicant also respectfully submits that the approval of the application will be in the interest of the various vendors participating in the event, which vendors also forms part of the public.

The Applicant therefore requests that the event licence in respect whereof application is made be granted.



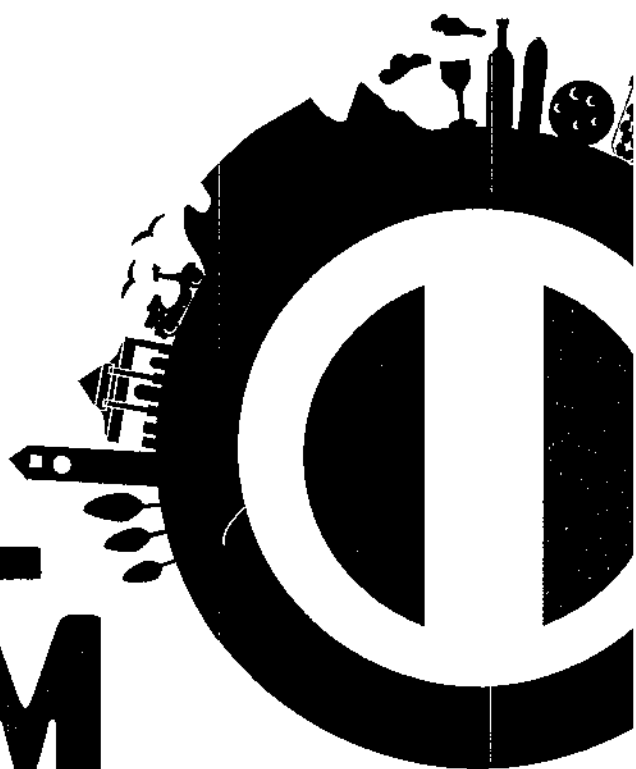
