3. **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this report is to inform the Councilors on progress made with the process to implement a Database at the Subcouncil for the selection of community workers for community based projects and programs. The selection methodology needs to ensure that unemployed unskilled or semi-skilled members of the community have fair access to ad-hoc **short term** community based work; that such members of the community are protected from both corruption and nepotism in attempting to gain such access and that the methodology is simple to understand, quick and easy to implement based on randomization computer selection process.

4. **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The report is submitted to inform the Subcouncil of community members that have registered on the Database and were successful in obtaining temporary employment. Attached name list as per **Annexures A** reflects the amount of work allocated to jobseekers per ward.

Additional application forms are available at the Subcouncil offices. The complete Database is available on request at the Sub council. It is important to

note that all requests for local labor must be directed through the Sub council by line departments. The names will be randomized and put forward for final selection/recruitment by the contractor. The sub council be informed on quarterly basis regarding community members benefiting on ad-hoc employment projects and programmers of the City.
