5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008, as amended by the Western Cape Liquor Amendment Act, 2010 and Western Cape Liquor Regulations, 2011 were implemented on 1 April 2012. The Act was implemented in phases: With effect from the 1 July 2017, event and temporary liquor licence applications are submitted to the City for comment. Council has delegated the authority to comment to the Subcouncils.
