PURPOSE

To decide on an application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6(2) A of the City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013

4. FOR DECISION BY

Subcouncil in terms of Delegation 4(2)

To approve, refuse or amend applications for extension of trading days and hrs. on premises where liquor licence have been granted in terms of Section 6(2) of the By-Law: Control of undertakings that sell liquor to the public; 2013.

5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013, was promulgated on 17 January and coming into effect on 01 February 2014.

An application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6 (1) of the By-Law was submitted to the Health Directorate and circulated to the relevant Departments for comment.

Clause 9 of the By-Law requires that the City must, before approving an application for the extension of trading days and hours, reasonably and fairly consider further factors which must include, inter alia-

- (a) The validity of the liquor licence;
- (b) Where applicable, the validity of a business licence issued in terms of the Businesses Act of 1991 (Act No. 71 of 1991);
- (c) Location category as per the Schedule;
- (d) Previous suspension, amendment or revocation of extended trading days and hours including previous records of complaints investigated and confirmed in respect of the last twelve months preceding a current application for extension:
- (e) The proximity of the licensed premises to surrounding residential zoned area, cultural, religious and educational facilities;
- (f) Outcome of community consultation and the recommendation of the relevant ward;
- (g) The potential impact on the surrounding environment;
- (h) Whether it is in the public interest to approve and grant an extension of trading days or hours; or
- (i) A motivation from the applicant dealing with the impact of
 - i. The risks to and nuisance on the surrounding community;
 - ii. Mitigation measures to assist the control of risks and nuisance; and
 - Possible benefits of extended liquor trading hours and days on the surrounding community
- (i) The basis and rationale behind all decision-making must be recorded

6. DISCUSSION

- 6.1 Section 6 (1) of the By-Law reads as follows:
- 6 (1) Subject to subsection (5), (6) and (7) a licensee may upon payment of the required free, submit a written application to the City to extend the liquor trading days and hours of licensed premises.

REASONS FOR APPLYING FOR SUNDAY TRADING HOURS

1. INTRODUCTION

- This is an application in terms of Section 6 of the City of Cape Town: Control of Undertaking that Sell Liquor to the Public by-law of 2013 for Sunday trading hours from 11:00 to 18H00 for the licensed off—consumption premises trading under name and style known as Tryphina's Place, WCP/037322 situate on Erf 18968 6 Dilo Street, Ekuphumleni, Khayelitsha in City of Cape Town, Khaya/Mitch district and in the magisterial district of Khayelitsha.
- 1.2 The applicant is applying for Sunday trading hours in that her present Sunday hours will lapse in or around June 2019.

2. THE APPLICANT

- 2.1 The applicant is Tryphina Adonis, identity number 680330 0082 089, unmarried with children who depend on her for support and maintenance.
- 2.2 She resides on the residential portion of the property with her family and the premises have been licensed for some time. The dominant use of the property is residential.
