3. PURPOSE

To request that corrective traffic measures be in place at Buitenzorg Road, between Oldenland Road and Parel Vallei Road sections and at the intersection of Bulties Way and Buitenzorg Road, Somerset West.

4. FOR DECISION BY

Decision by Council

Delegation 9.1 to decide within its area of jurisdiction where traffic calming measures are to be applied subject to the relevant legislation and policy either considering a report from the Transport & Urban Development Authority Department.

5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Buitenzorg Road is very narrow with no road markings with an ECD and businesses are on the road. No pavements and pedestrians and cyclists use this road and there is a need for a speed reduction to 40 k/phr. A meeting was held with Mr & Mrs Whittle and the residents on 14 October 2020.

Sub-council 24 has sent the request to the Transport Network Development Authority (TDA), which will undertake a technical assessment. The TDA will interact with the Ward Councillor where necessary and provide written comment on the progress to the Sub-Council Manager. Attached herewith request forms, illustrating a description of the problem. See Annexure E.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS

- a) That the Sub-council supports and recommends the proposed request for remedial measures at Buitenzorg Road.
- b) That the request be forwarded to the Transport Department for their action and be placed on the Matters Receiving Attention for monitoring.
