To decide on an application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6(1) of the City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013

3. FOR DECISION BY

SubCouncil in terms of Delegation 4(2)

To approve, refuse or vary applications for extension of trading hours on premises where liquor licences have been granted.

4. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013, was promulgated on 17 January and coming into effect on 01 February 2014.

An application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6 (1) of the By-law was submitted to the Health Directorate and circulated to the relevant departments for comment. The fully signed application, including all required comments, was submitted to the SubCouncil 16 Manager, and was then circulated to abutting neighbours, all organisations included on the Ward 74 database and ward committee members for comment.

Clause 9 of the By-law requires that the City must, before approving an application for the extension of trading days and hours, reasonably and fairly consider further factors which must include, inter alia-

- (a) the validity of the liquor licence;
- (b) where applicable, the validity of a business licence issued in terms of the Businesses Act of 1991 (Act No. 71 of 1991);

- (c) location category as per the Schedule;
- (d) previous suspension, amendment or revocation of extended trading days and hours including previous records of complaints investigated and confirmed in respect of the last twelve months preceding a current application for extension;
- (e) the proximity of the licensed premises to surrounding residential zoned area, cultural, religious and educational facilities;
- (f) outcome of community consultation and the recommendation of the relevant ward:
- (g) the potential impact on the surrounding environment;
- (h) whether it is in the public interest to approve and grant an extension of trading days or hours; or
- (i) a motivation from the applicant dealing with the impact of -
 - (i) the risks to and nuisances on the surrounding community;
 - (ii) mitigation measures to assist the control of risks and nuisances; and
 - (iii) possible benefits of extended liquor trading hours and days on the surrounding community.
- (10) The basis and rationale behind all decision-making must be recorded.

5. DISCUSSION

- 5.1 Section 6 (1) of the By-Law reads as follows:
 6(1) Subject to subsection (5), (6) and (7) a licensee may upon payment of the required fee, submit a written application to the City to extend the liquor trading days and hours of licensed premises.

RENEWAL APPLICATION BY MARINER'S WHARF (PTY) LTD FOR THE EXTENSION OF TRADING DAYS TO INCLUDE SUNDAYS FROM 11H00 - 18H00 IN RESPECT OF MARINER'S WHARF LIQUOR COVE (WCP/013557) LOCATED AT LOT 50, HOUT BAY HARBOUR, HOUT BAY, 7806, WESTERN CAPE

1. THE APPLICANT

We act herein, on behalf of Mariner's Wharf (Pty) Ltd who are the owners and operators of Mariner's Wharf located upon Lot 50, Hout Bay Harbour, Hout Bay, 7806.

2. VALIDITY OF LICENCE

Attached hereto and marked Annexure "A" is a copy of the Form 21A, annual licence renewal notice in respect of WCP/013557 together with proof of payment of renewal fee for the 2020 year.

Attached hereto, marked Annexure "B" is the approval of our client's application for extended trading days to include Sundays from 11h00-18h00 for the year 2019.

3. LOCATION AND ZONING

The liquor store is located upon Lot 50, Hout Bay Harbour and is in the heart of the Hout Bay Harbour tourist development. The premises is visited by a large number of foreign and local tourist and is one of the major tourist attractions of the Western Cape Province.

It will be seen from the aerial photo attached hereto and marked Annexure "C" that the premises is located within the tourist precinct of Hout Bay Harbour and is surrounded by many businesses related to the holiday and tourism trade.

4. PROXIMITY OF RESIDENTS AND CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS

There are no residential, cultural, religious or educational facilities in the vicinity that may possibly be detrimentally affected by the extension of the days as applied for. This is clearly depicted by the photograph attached hereto.

5. THE BUSINESS AND MANAGEMENT

The applicant has an impeccable record as far as the sale of liquor is concerned and enjoys an excellent reputation. The applicant adheres to the letter and spirit of the Liquor Legislation and great care is taken not to give offense, either to the shopping public or to any other member of the community in which the store is located.

6. IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT AND COMMUNITY

It is submitted that the granting of this application will have no detrimental effect on any member of the community or impact negatively on the environment. The applicant has traded on Sundays for almost a quarter of a century and in all that time has operated in full harmony with the environment and the community. There is no reason to suppose that this will not be the case in the future.

7. REASON FOR REQUIRING EXTENDED HOURS AND DAYS

Sundays, in particular, is the day of the week upon which the premises is visited by a large number of foreign tourists, local residents and local tourists.

Consumers have become accustomed to the fact that they are able to purchase their liquor requirements when visiting Mariner's Wharf. It is to be noted that this is not a run-of-the-mill liquor store but that the store, both in its layout and with regard to the products offered, is of an upmarket nature in order to appeal to the target market which includes a large number of foreign tourists.

It is submitted that, in keeping with the trend across South Africa, Sunday has become a major shopping day for the public. As the store is located in the heart of a major tourist attraction, it is also conveniently located for the public to make their liquor purchases on Sundays when visiting the Hout Bay Harbour.

In view of the location of the premises, there is no possibility, whatsoever, that allowing them to trade on a Sunday, can be detrimental either to the neighbourhood or the community at large.

It is submitted that the closing of legitimate outlets on Sunday is not only a great inconvenience to shoppers but is also of great benefit to illegal outlets, which thrive during those times when legitimate outlets are forced to close.

Trading on Sundays is also important to the staff of Mariner's Wharf as there is a distinct possibility that the closure of the liquor store on Sundays will lead to staff retrenchments.

8. RISK OF NUISANCE AND MEASURES TO CONTROL RISKS

In view of the location of the premises, the extension of the trading days to Sundays will hold no risk of nuisance to the surrounding community and, indeed, will be of great benefit to them. The proof of the pudding is in the eating and it is a fact that having the liquor store open on Sundays for many years has not given rise to any nuisance to the public. It is further submitted that the management of the liquor store is of a high standard and that no nuisance or risk to the public will be allowed.

9. PUBLIC INTEREST

Lastly, we submit that it is clearly in the public interest for the consumer to be able to purchase his or her liquor requirements when visiting a tourist attraction of this nature. It is further in the public interest to ensure that legal outlets which are properly conducted and controlled are allowed to trade, instead of forcing the public to visit shebeens and other unsavoury, dangerous establishments to obtain their liquor requirements.

In the premises, we submit that the granting of this application will be in the public interest and request that the application be granted.




