SubCouncil in terms of Delegation 4(2)

To approve, refuse or vary applications for extension of trading hours on premises where liquor licences have been granted.

4. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013, was promulgated on 17 January and coming into effect on 01 February 2014.

An application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6 (1) of the By-law was submitted to the Health Directorate and circulated to the relevant departments for comment. The fully signed application, including all required comments, was submitted to the SubCouncil 16 Manager, and was then circulated to abutting neighbours, all organisations included on the Ward 115 database and ward committee members for comment.

Clause 9 of the By-law requires that the City must, before approving an application for the extension of trading days and hours, reasonably and fairly consider further factors which must include, inter alia-

- (a) the validity of the liquor licence;
- (b) where applicable, the validity of a business licence issued in terms of the Businesses Act of 1991 (Act No. 71 of 1991);

- (c) location category as per the Schedule;
- (d) previous suspension, amendment or revocation of extended trading days and hours including previous records of complaints investigated and confirmed in respect of the last twelve months preceding a current application for extension;
- (e) the proximity of the licensed premises to surrounding residential zoned area, cultural, religious and educational facilities;
- (f) outcome of community consultation and the recommendation of the relevant ward;
- (g) the potential impact on the surrounding environment;
- (h) whether it is in the public interest to approve and grant an extension of trading days or hours; or
- (i) a motivation from the applicant dealing with the impact of -
 - (i) the risks to and nuisances on the surrounding community;
 - (ii) mitigation measures to assist the control of risks and nuisances; and
 - (iii) possible benefits of extended liquor trading hours and days on the surrounding community.
- (10) The basis and rationale behind all decision-making must be recorded.

5. DISCUSSION

- 5.1 Section 6 (1) of the By-Law reads as follows: 6(1) Subject to subsection (5), (6) and (7) a licensee may upon payment of the required fee, submit a written application to the City to extend the liquor trading days and hours of licensed premises.





1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 On 2019-09-17 this office received a request from City of Cape Town for comments with regard to the extension of trading hours Robinson's Liquors (PTY) LTD for trading as Ultra Liquors with WCP/036016

2. THE PREMISES

- 2.1 The applicant is Robinson's Liquors (PTY) LTD trading as Ultra Liquors situated at Cnr Main and Varneys Road, Green Point.
- 2.2 The premises is allocated on Main Road Green Point in close proximate of residential block of flats.

3. CRIME AND POLICING

- 3.1 This does not foresee any increase in the crime rate due to the extension of trading hours.
- 3.2 The applicant always trade within the perimeters of the Act.

REPRESENTATIONS IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR EXTENDED TRADING HOURS MONDAY TO SATURDAY ULTRA LIQUORS GREEN POINT

NOTE:

This is a further application for **renewal** of authority for extended trading hours Monday to Saturday, such authority having been granted for the period 11 December 2018 until 10 December 2019 under Reference Number 184380 16 SUB 27/1/2018 – WCP/036016. A copy of the approval is included for easy reference as **ANNEXURE** "A".

The representations in support of the previous, initial, application, was as follows:

1. INTRODUCTION:

These representations serve in support of the application in the form of Form 2, as prescribed in respect of a request for the approval of extended Trading Hours, Monday up to and including Saturday.

The application is brought by Robinson Liquors (Pty) Ltd, the holder of the Liquor Store licence in respect of which this application is brought before the city of Cape Town. The details of the Applicant are contained in Form 2.

The application is in respect of an Ultra Liquors Liquor Store, full details of the address and locality of which are contained in Form 2.

It is an existing liquor store which is being conducted in terms of a valid off-consumption liquor registration, a copy of which is annexed hereto as **ANNEXURE** "B".

2. NATURE OF DEVELOPMENT:

An Ultra Liquors liquor store is an upmarket, large and well-stocked liquor store with a large variety of products and brands and due to the positive marketing the licensee does, it is not a convenience liquor store, but a destination store. People come to Ultra for the variety and the well-priced products. An Ultra liquor store is always situated at a strategic point on a main thoroughfare with its own parking for the convenience of shoppers. *In casu*, the store is situated on **Main Road**, **Green Point** and it has its own exclusive parking facilities.

The store is a spacious, self-service liquor store which is well-stocked and great emphasis is placed on a wide variety of quality wines.

3. NATURE OF BUSINESS:

An Ultra is not a convenience store or a neighbourhood store or even an anchor tenant in a large mall. It usually is a stand-alone development which is a destination store situated on a main route and which draws its customer base from far afield. In Cape Town there are four Ultra stores which are located in such a way that it can properly serve all customers in and around the greater Cape Town area.

The store is situated "on the way home" and in the past a great deal of the turnover was generated between four o'clock and eight o'clock in the summer months from November to April. The Applicant wishes to retain this service for its clients.

The store has its own parking facilities in front of it just off the street, which is a main route from the city towards the residential areas which makes it convenient for stopping at on the way from work to home in the afternoon.

On the other hand it is situated in a business development and it did not and will not have a negative impact on its surrounding area.

It is submitted that there is no reason to believe that the impact of later trading hours will be different from what it was when trading was allowed until eight o'clock at night. Being an off-consumption facility drinking does not take place at the business neither near the business and the Applicant takes great care to prevent illegal drinking.

4. NATURE OF THE SURROUNDING AREA:

The premises is situated in a loose standing building in which the applicant has a KwikSpar and the liquor store premises. It is situated on Main Road, Green Point and the entrance into the store faces onto a parking area at the back of the store, in other words on the opposite side of Main Road.

The layout of the building and the parking area is such that the applicant has full control of people going to and coming from the store and its adjacent KwikSpar, which makes control very easy and efficient.

On the opposite side of the parking area and to the left, as well as the right, of the building, there are flat units, but the business does not have any impact on the same, due to the almost secluded locality of the development.

5. ITEMS / SECTION 9 OF THE BY-LAW:

- a. A copy of the liquor licence is attached and from the face of it, it is clear that it is validly in force.
- b. As no fresh produce is sold in the liquor store nor any food prepared, no entertainment is offered and no accommodation is offered, a permit in terms of the Businesses Act is not required.
- c. It is submitted that the location category and the nature of the development qualifies for Sunday trading.
- d. There is no previous suspensions and the like as is contemplated in Section 9(d). The nature of the development and the locality thereof and the nature of trading is such that it will not have any impact on any residential area, place of worship, place of education or the like, if Sunday trading is allowed on the Sunday as was dealt with above.
- e. On the basis of what was already said above, it is believed that there is no risk of any nuisance or inconvenience to the surrounding communities. The very nature of the development is such that it has reduced the risk of any kind of nuisance to the surrounding area, to the minimum, if not zero.

6. PUBLIC INTEREST:

According to the decisions of the High Court of South Africa, public interest is doing something which, if done, better serves the public than when not done.

Especially in summer, Capetonians have a late afternoon with the sun only setting at eight at night making six to eight in Summer even more "day" than four to six in Winter. It follows naturally that people also shop later in summer and this is what the Applicant wishes to offer its patrons.

7. TRACK RECORD:

Ultra has an immaculate track record of trading according to the rule of the book. The signatory to this application has been doing all Ultra's liquor related work since 1998, country-wide and never was there any occasion where there was any even vague allegation that a Ultra Liquor Store gives rise to nuisance or undesirable circumstances and there is really no grounds for believing that this will be different in the Western Cape if it is allowed to trade like it did all along.

8. **NEW SUBMISSION:**

During the year of trading there were no incidences which can in any way indicate that the authorising of Sunday trading had a negative impact on the general public or even any smaller group of the public, such as the public in the immediate surroundings of the store.

9. PRAYER:

It is prayed that <u>renewal</u> of extended trading hours up to 20:00 pm Monday to Saturday should be granted to and allowed for Robinson Liquors (Pty) Ltd trading as Ultra Liquors Green Point, even if it is only during the summer months as it is not necessary for the winter months.
