

**MOTION FOR SUB-COUNCIL 10 FOR THE SCHEDULED SUB-COUNCIL MEETING ON 15 October 2017**

**Councillor MF Cassim proposes:**

**That, firstly,** in view of President Ramaphosa's announcement on Friday 21 September 2018 that a township and rural entrepreneurship fund was being established to provide finance to either scale up existing projects or provide start-up capital for new projects, and, furthermore, in view of the City itself demarcating Monwabisi Beach as a site for nodal development.

**That secondly,** in view of the motion moved by myself and seconded by councillor Mngxunyeneni which was accepted by the full council in 2017 to upgrade Spine Road into a main road along which a variety of businesses could spring up.

**That Sub-Council 10 therefore resolves as follows:**

- (1) It is common cause amongst all three levels of government that townships such as Khayelitsha, with a population exceeding a million people, has to be supported to ignite economic development through a substantial revamping of what was previously planned and designed by the apartheid government in order to transform each such dormitory township into a fully functioning town in the new democratic dispensation which offers economic opportunities through the stimulation of entrepreneurial activity leading to an expansion of the GDP.
- (2) That the city will swiftly and expeditiously present to the national government plans and projects which are already in place needing a boost in funding to maximize development and thereafter following up as swiftly as possible with plans to attract start-up capital from the newly established fund for the upgrading of Spine Road, the development of Monwabisi Beach accommodating residential as well as commercial structures, and the widening of the two bridges over the N2 leading to Mew Way and to Spine Road so that large scale entrepreneurial activity is stimulated and private investment is attracted.
- (3) That this resolution serves before the full council
