To decide on an application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6(1) of the City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013

3. FOR DECISION BY

SubCouncil in terms of Delegation 4(2)

To approve, refuse or vary applications for extension of trading hours on premises where liquor licences have been granted.

4. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013, was promulgated on 17 January and coming into effect on 01 February 2014.

An application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6 (1) of the By-law was submitted to the Health Directorate and circulated to the relevant departments for comment. The fully signed application, including all required comments, was submitted to the SubCouncil 16 Manager, and was then circulated to abutting neighbours, all organisations included on the Ward 74 database and ward committee members for comment.

Clause 9 of the By-law requires that the City must, before approving an application for the extension of trading days and hours, reasonably and fairly consider further factors which must include, inter alia-

- (a) the validity of the liquor licence;
- (b) where applicable, the validity of a business licence issued in terms of the Businesses Act of 1991 (Act No. 71 of 1991);

- (c) location category as per the Schedule;
- (d) previous suspension, amendment or revocation of extended trading days and hours including previous records of complaints investigated and confirmed in respect of the last twelve months preceding a current application for extension;
- (e) the proximity of the licensed premises to surrounding residential zoned area, cultural, religious and educational facilities;
- (f) outcome of community consultation and the recommendation of the relevant ward;
- (g) the potential impact on the surrounding environment;
- (h) whether it is in the public interest to approve and grant an extension of trading days or hours; or
- (i) a motivation from the applicant dealing with the impact of -
 - (i) the risks to and nuisances on the surrounding community;
 - (ii) mitigation measures to assist the control of risks and nuisances; and
 - (iii) possible benefits of extended liquor trading hours and days on the surrounding community.
- (10) The basis and rationale behind all decision-making must be recorded.

5. DISCUSSION

- 6.1 Section 6 (1) of the By-Law reads as follows:
 6(1) Subject to subsection (5), (6) and (7) a licensee may upon payment of the required fee, submit a written application to the City to extend the liquor trading days and hours of licensed premises.





1. General comments

- 1.1 It needs to be noted that as Sub Council is aware, this outlet has been trading in terms of the By-Law since it was granted in 2014, without any problems.
- 1.2 Section 6(9)(d) of the By-Law does not apply as there has been no previous suspension, amendment or revocation of extended trading days and hours, including previous records of complaints investigated and confirmed in respect of the last 12 months preceding the current application for extension.
- 1.3 Taking into consideration the above, it is submitted that the granting of this application will still be in the public interest as contemplated in Section 6(9)(h).

2. Report by City of Cape Town, Liquor Law Enforcement Department

The report attached to this application is once again positive in all aspects and gave Tops At Hout Bay a clean bill of health stating that there were not any problems regarding the trading of the store. No objection was filed by Cape Town Law Enforcement Department against this establishment.

3. Report by SAPS

As can be seen from the attached report, SAPS recommends the application.

4. Conclusion

It is applicant's submission that Sub Council, when deciding on these applications, take the above representations into consideration and to afford the applicant the opportunity to carry on trading (without problems to the community) as it has been doing in the past.
