5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report is for the health facilities within the boundaries of subcouncil 6 for the period 1 October 2019 to 31 December 2019. The report covers both Personal Primary Health Care (PPHC) and Environmental Health Services (EH). Overall the facilities are doing well and are meeting most of its targets (detailed performance report available on request).

7. DISCUSSION/CONTENTS

City Health Department is responsible for two main focus areas of service delivery namely; Personal Primary Health Care (PPHC) which includes Kasselsvlei Clinic, Parow Clinic and St. Vincent CDC as well as Environmental Health Services (EH). The performance of each unit is presented below as measured against specific set SDBIP taraets.

7.1 PERSONAL PRIMARY HEALTH CARE

This part of the report highlights performance of the clinics in relation to the SDBIP, focusing on key indicators namely reduction of HIV, AIDS, TB & Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI), reduction of death rate for children under 5 years, antenatal care & teenage pregnancy.

Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV), Acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS), and Tuberculosis (TB) & Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) Programme:

This programme is aimed at preventing and reducing the aforementioned diseases and related deaths. For the period under review, performance for this programme is as follows: -

All facilities did not meet the target for the number of total clients tested for HIV. Facilities will relook at current practices, and do more promotional activities to emphasize the importance of testing.

All the facilities exceeded the targets for the number of new clients enrolled on antiretroviral treatment and the percentage of HIV positive TB patients commenced on anti-retroviral treatment.

All facilities did not meet the target for the number of male condoms distributed, except Kasselsvlei clinic, Clinic distribution has increased from last quarter and is actively looking for new distribution sites, more health talks are given on the importance of dual protection.

Child and Youth Health

Programmes under child health and youth health are aimed at preventing and reducing childhood and youth diseases as well as deaths related to such diseases. Child and Youth Health programmes performance are as follows: -

Health care facilities exceeded the target for the percentage immunisation coverage from hexavalent 1st dose to fully immunised under one year and the percentage of preschools visited.

The target for the number of reproductive health clients under 18 years were met at all facilities, except St Vincent CDC. Clinic booked appointment with schools to render service.

Target met for the number of visits to schools for health promotion outreach programmes, except St. Vincent CDC. Clinic booked appointments with 4 schools.

Women's Health

Women's Health is one of the priority programmes that the City monitors very closely. This programme is aimed at preventing and reducing disease and deaths of women as result of cancer, child birth etc.

All health facilities met the target for the number of cervical smear coverage, except St Vincent CDC. Home based carers have started recruiting at home visits and on Friday the SPN goes to Chestnut Satellite clinic. There has been an improvement since October.

All health care facilities exceeded the target for percentage antenatal 1st visits before 20 weeks, except St Vincent CDC. More awareness campaigns will be held both in the facility and the community to educate clients on the importance of booking early in pregnancies.

Health facilities did not meet the target the number of female condoms distributed, except Kasselsvlei clinic. Female condoms are still a challenge due to reluctance of the community to use it, but the department will continue to raise awareness.

7.2 ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

This part of the report covers the performance of Environmental Health Services on key SDBIP indicators.

Informal Settlements

Once a week environmental health practitioners (EHP) visit every informal settlement to monitor conditions. For the period under review the EHP's have done 169 visits against the target of 169, i.e. target exceeded for the reporting period. However, the target for health and hygiene projects in informal settlements was not met.

Water Safety & Quality

A total of 273 water samples were tested and all were compliant with the quality standards, thus exceeding the target for compliance of 99% for the subdistrict.

All (100%) of the samples tested were compliant with the quality standards, thus exceeding the target of 99% for the subdistrict. These samples are taken at strategic points linked to the end users.

Vectors are responsible for carrying various illnesses from one place to the other, therefore their control and management is important. The target for number of block bailing stations serviced for controlling rats was not met.

Food Hygiene and Safety

On a regular basis, environmental health practitioners (EHPs) take food samples from various outlets/businesses to monitor food hygiene and safety. These samples included food products, bacteriological swabs from the hands of food handlers and surfaces where food products are prepared.

A number of 185 food samples were tested and 158 (85%) were compliant with legislation standards, thus exceeding the target of 75% for the sub district. The necessary remedial actions were taken in all cases of non-compliance which included written notices to owners and managers of restaurants and butcheries.

Pre-School visits

A total of 396 (100%) pre-schools were visited during the reporting period in order to ensure compliance to the relevant environmental health standards for child care centers. Monitoring of these facilities include health and safety aspects referred to in terms of the Early Childhood Policy of the City of Cape Town and the Regulations Governing General Hygiene Requirements and the Transport of Food. Target was exceeded.
