

## HAVE YOUR SAY! DRAFT HUMAN SETTLEMENTS STRATEGY

The City of Cape Town invites residents to comment on the Draft Human Settlements Strategy.

The Strategy seeks to address the shortcomings of the current housing system and to enable integrated communities and support sustainable city development. It recognises the extent of informal housing in Cape Town, the cost of producing a home within the formal housing system, and the desire of all households to build their own houses or provide housing opportunities for others.

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input to the municipality from 1 September 2020 to 30 November 2020.

The proposed Draft Human Settlements Strategy together with its executive summary will be available for viewing on the City of Cape Town website: www.capetown.gov.za/haveyoursay. In addition, the executive summary of the Strategy will be available in English, Xhosa and Afrikaans at subcouncil offices during the public participation period.
