7. DISCUSSION/CONTENTS

Council at its meeting held on 13 December 2018 resolved vide item C06/012/18 as reflected below. This report is submitted in terms of paragraph (iii) below; since all sub-delegations conferred in terms of the system of delegations dated 11 August 2016 had been revoked. Subcouncil considered matters resolved on by the Subcouncil Manager in consultation with the Subcouncil Chairperson and Ward Councillor at its meetings held in January and February 2019 respectively which were submitted only for noting / record purposes.

It will therefore be required to now condone these decisions to ensure legal compliance.

- (ii) the System of Delegations be re-numbered and then published on the Intranet, and comes into force when the City Manager communicates such date of publication to the organisation
- (iii) once the System of Delegations comes into force, the System of Delegations originally adopted on 11 August 2016, and as amended, as well as delegations and subdelegations flowing therefrom, will no longer be of any force or effect
- (iv) all decisions taken under the previous System of Delegations remain in force
- (v) all delegating authorities who may wish to sub-delegate in terms of this new System of Delegations, must do so in writing
- (vi) the Executive Directors ensure that all sub-delegations are developed by the time the document is published on the Intranet, and are authorized once the System of Delegations is in force.
