- c. That in the event of subcouncil delegation 4(2) which deals with extended liquor trading days and hours, and which due to time constraints cannot be submitted to one of the scheduled subcouncil meetings for consideration, the subcouncil manager or acting subcouncil manager, in consultation with the chairperson and the relevant ward councillor, be authorized to deal with and finalise such matter(s).
- d. That a report be submitted to the ensuing meeting of the subcouncil to report on the exercising of such delegation(s).
- e. That a quarterly report be submitted to Council in terms of delegations exercised during the report period.
