7.6 Report for period October 2018 - December 2018

This report provides information about the programmes and Ward allocation projects implemented by the SD&ECD's Eastern Area within Sub Council 22 for the period October 2018 – December 2018.

7.6.1. Strengthening Families Programme

Definition: This is a licensed, structured, evidence based life skills programme that improves family relationship and reduces their vulnerability to substance abuse.

Objective: To facilitate a holistic programme to increase the resilience of children aged 9-11 within family groups.

Outcome:

- To enhance the children protective and resilience factors by improving children social and life skills, peer resistance and communication skills.
- To improved parent/child attachment and family relations, communication and organization.
- To improve adult parenting skills, reductions in excessive punishment or lax discipline and improvement in parenting self-efficiency.
- To reduce youth behavior problems (i.e substance abuse, conduct disorders, aggression, violence and juvenile delinquency) as well as reduced emotional problems psychosomatic disorders.

7.6.2. Local network of cares (LNOC)

Definition: To build the capacity of LNOC through leadership and governance training.

Objective: To build the capacity of Local network of care to increase their effectiveness to deal with persons at risks of living on the street.

Outcome:

- Well organized structure of the network to ensure effective efficient service for the street people.

7.6.3 Youth Development

Indicator: Implement a youth development campaign

Title of project/intervention: Career Expo

Objective: The objective of the youth campaigns is to provide the youth of the City with services, opportunities and support available on career related matters.

Outcome: More youth from Cape Town are able to access support, opportunities and services that are relevant to them.
