MOTION TO SUBCOUNCIL 6 - SCHEDULE 14 JUNE 2019

SUBJECT: Traffic calming/Congestion relief at Robert Sebukwe and Amandel Roads, Belhar including the installation of guard rails on the open space, Erf 17030

BACKGROUND

Commuters using Robert Sebukwe and Amandel Roads in Belhar have been expressing concerns about increased congestion on these roads. No "slipway" exists to reduce the congestion to assist with the traffic calming.

Due to the increased congestion on these roads, the taxi drivers illegally uses the open space, Erf 17030, to avoid the congested roads. The illegal use of the open space by the taxi drivers may result in injuries to pedestrians who uses the open space which are opposite the school.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. That the Transport Department investigate for the construction of a slipway at Robert Sebukwe and Amandel Roads to reduce the traffic congestion
- 2. That guard railings be installed at the open space, Erf 17030, to prevent taxis from transversing this open space
- 3. That the Motion be referred to Portfolio for consideration.
