APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- A limited gambling machine premises licence is required for any premises in the Western Cape in or on which limited gambling machines ("LGM's") are placed by the holder of a limited gambling machine operator licence.
- A "limited gambling machine" means a slot machine as prescribed in the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Law, 1996 (No 4 of 1996), as amended ("Law").
- "Premises" means any site, place or location, situated on immovable property, in respect of which an application for a limited gambling machine ficence is made.
- 4. For each application for a limited gambling machine premises licence, Parts Two and Four of this proforms must be completed and a report must be furnished in respect of the information required in Part Three.
- 5. The application form must also be accompanied by a certified copy of the title deed pertaining to the Premises together with a conveyancer's certificate stating that the envisaged gambling activity is not in conflict with any conditions set out in the said title deed.
- Return the completed form with five copies to the Manager: Licensing, Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board, P O Box 8175, ROGGEBAAI, 8012 or deliver it by hand to the 8th Floor, S A Reserve Bank Building, 60 St George's Mall, Cape Town, 8001.
- 7. All dates must be in the format: Day / Month / Year.

- 2.1.1 the building where LGM's are to be installed;
- 2.1.2 the number of LGM's and their location within the establishment;
- 2.1.3 how the designated area will be made inaccessible to persons under the age of 18;
- 2.1.4 how adequate control, other than by way of physical layout, is to be exercised to preclude persons under the age of 18 years from gaining access to LGM's;
- 2.1.5 whether the floor space used for the LGM's is more than 25% of the floor space used for the primary activity;
- 2.1.6 Whether the machines are placed in such a manner as to provide for an unobstructed view of each LGM from the point of supervision, any mirrors necessary to maintain adequate supervision and any video surveillance equipment that will be used for supervision;

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- 2.1.7 whether the gambling area at least 3 square meters per LGM:
- 2.1.8 whether the machines are at least 2 m from the cordoned off area. If not, whether a non-transparent continuous wall of at least two metres in height is provided and the machines are at least two metres from any aperture in such wall;
- 2.1.9 whether there is a separate cordoned-off area or a restricted area as contemplated in the Liquor Act, 1989 (Act 27 of 1989) where applicable;
- 2.1.10 whether photographs are attached showing the existing interior and exterior of the premises;
- 2.1.11 whether the premises are immovable, and
- 2.1.12 whether an application for a business licence has simultaneously been lodged with the Municipality. (where three or more LGM's per site have been applied for)

- 3.1.6 what signage will be displayed advertising the availability of LGM's on the site;
- 3.1.7 Whether the envisaged activity is compatible with the zoning of the property as per the local authority's town planning scheme;

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- 3.1.8 whether the site falls within one of the preferred categories of primary activities as set out in paragraph 2.5.6 of the manual;
- 3.1.9 whether the site falls within one of the 'not preferred' sites as set out in paragraph 2.5.7 of the manual (including house shops) and, if so, which one. Motivate in full why it is deemed appropriate to conduct a gambling activity on this site, and
- 3.1.10 whether the premises can link up with the Central Monitoring System.


