BACKGROUND

Ward 1 is experiencing a lack of service delivery in reinstatement of roads and pavements where work has been done on water infrastructure due to water pipe bursts, maintenance and upgrades.

At the Sub Council 3 Activity day on 15 October 2019, the Sub Council was informed that at a depot level in the Northern District, there are insufficient staff to supervise with inter alia tenderers doing these reinstatements. This leads to poor service delivery. Some of the work has been dormant for many months and in some cases years.

- C. That feedback be provided to some extent as to when the outstanding reinstatements will receive the necessary attention it needs
