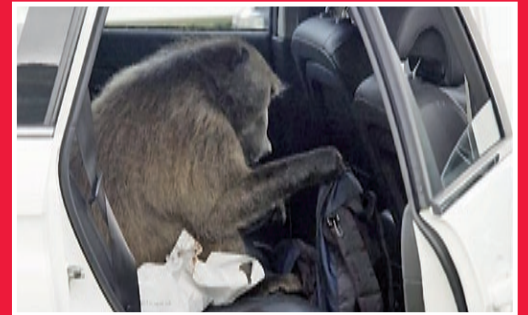


Baboons are **WILD** and must be treated with **RESPECT**

This could end in serious injury to people and may lead to the euthanasia of earmarked baboons!
