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## THE GREAT GREEN OUTDOORS

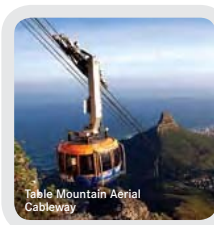

The 'Mother City' is also situated in an international "Biodiversity Hotspot", the Cape Floristic Region and is recognised globally for its extraordinarily rich, diverse and unique fauna and flora. The city offers many ways to experience the great green outdoors.

#### 01 Table Mountain (TMNP)

Arguably one of the most well-known mountains in Africa, this is a mountain of many moods and offers walkers and hikers a range of routes that vary from strolls to rigorous hikes. If you want the views without the climb, catch a state-of-the-art revolving cable car to the top.



#### 02 Table Mountain Aerial Cableway

The Cableway takes you to the summit of Table Mountain in less than 10 minutes. The cable car's rotating floor ensures that all visitors get a 360° aerial view of Cape Town.

#### 03 Lions Head (TMNP)

A short but popular hike that offers 360 degree views of the Atlantic seaboard, the city and Table Mountain.

#### 04 Signal Hill (TMNP)

It is from here that the noon day gun marks 12:00 in Cape Town.

#### 05 Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden (SANBI)

World-renowned for the beauty and diversity of the Cape flora and for its setting against the eastern slopes of Table Mountain. Kirstenbosch grows

only indigenous South African plants. The estate covers 528 hectares and supports a diverse fynbos flora and natural forest. The cultivated garden (36 hectares) displays collections of South African plants, particularly those from the winter rainfall region of the country.

#### 06 Tokai Arboretum (TMNP)

Established in 1886, the purpose was to test which trees from other parts of the world would grow well in this location. Walk or ride your mountain bike in the adjacent plantations of this peaceful setting, or use it as the starting point for a longer hike.

#### 07 Silvermine (TMNP)

Silvermine offers some of the best hikes in the Park with beautiful fynbos landscapes. There are two sections with formal parking.

Gate One: Coming from Cape Town turn right off Ou Kaapse Weg (M64).  
Gate Two: Pass Gate One and a few hundred metres on, turn left.

#### 08 Boulders (TMNP)

World famous for its thriving colony of African Penguins and magnificent wind-sheltered, safe beaches. It is one of the few sites where this vulnerable bird can be observed at close range in a protected natural environment.
