The False Bay Ecology Park Environmental Education Centre is situated on the eastern shores of Zeekoevlei and runs 3-day/2-night overnight camps on a similar basis to the Zeekoevlei Environmental Education Centre. At present there are no bush camp facilities and both nights are spent at the centre. The maximum number that can be accommodated is 120 (minimum 60).

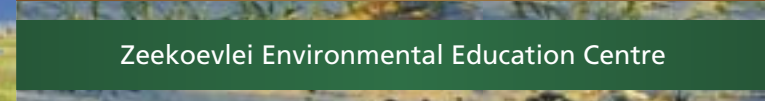

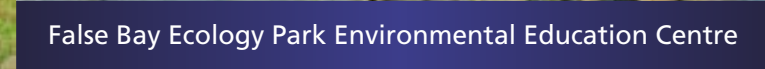

Rondevlei Nature Reserve



Rondevlei Nature Reserve offers guided 3-hour programmes which focus on an overview of the nature reserve and its importance. Special emphasis may be requested on topics such as plants, birds, mammals, wetlands, fynbos or pollution.

The programmes are suitable for grades 1-12 and can be offered in English or Afrikaans. A maximum number of 50 children can be accommodated per visit. Morning programmes run on weekdays only from 09h00 to 12h00 and afternoon programmes from 13h30 to 16h30 (13h30 – 15h30 on Fridays).

Entrance is free for pre-booked education visits. Advanced booking is essential. Teachers/Leaders are expected to assist with controlling the group. Facilities include a trail beside the wetland with lookout towers and bird hides. There is also an environmental centre with an aquarium, live reptiles, porcupines and a museum. The reserve also has picnic areas and toilets.

Zeekoevlei Environmental Education Centre



The Zeekoevlei Environmental Education Centre offers high quality, low cost 3-day/2-night overnight outdoor camps. Trained and experienced field rangers run a variety of environmental and youth development programmes which can be tailored to suit the clients' needs. Youth spend one night at a fully-furnished facility on the shores of Zeekoevlei, and one night sleeping on raised platforms under trees on the shores of Rondevlei. This is a good opportunity to see the resident hippo's.

The programmes are a mix of education and fun. The education component includes the use of the facilities at Rondevlei and covers similar topics. The programme also offers guided visits to the Cape Flats Waste Water Works, the Coastal Park landfill site, the beach, orientation trails and more. Fun activities include raft building, obstacle courses and dragon boating. Programmes can be supported in English, Afrikaans and Xhosa and are run throughout the year, including holidays and weekends.

Bookings as well as a pre-camp meeting are essential.

The maximum number that can be accommodated is 50. (minimum 25)
