Conditions and safety rules

The ARTS is an operational site with accompanying safety rules. When visiting the ARTS Resource Centre, these rules will be explained to learners/visitors with the proviso that they be adhered to at all times. Council reserves the right to cancel or curtail visits in the event that these conditions are not complied with.

Conditions for booking

- A visit to the ARTS is recommended for learners from Grade 4 and up.
- All school groups/minors must be under adult supervision. School groups/minors are requested to maintain a minimum of one teacher/adult for every 10 learners/minors.
- Groups are limited to 30 individuals per group. Split tours for larger groups can be requested. This is, however, subject to the availability of staff.
- A visit to the ARTS should be booked at least one term in advance. The Solid Waste Management Department will, however, try to accommodate bookings at short notice.
- Your provisional booking must be made by fax to the Solid Waste Management booking office.
- Written notice of cancellation of the excursion/visit must be done two weeks prior to the reserved date.

In 2002/3 2,3 million tons of waste was generated by residents, visitors and businesses in Cape Town - that is almost 2 kg per person a day on average. Waste generation is growing at almost 7% per annum – faster than our city's population growth rate of 1,7%. Three of the City's landfill sites are already closed, and the remaining three are filling up fast.

The City's Solid Waste Management Department is striving to create awareness of the cause and effect of poor waste management, and the benefits of integrated waste management. Educators, learners and their families are important partners in the City's efforts. In order to expose learners to the waste stream journey, the City offers learners the opportunity to visit one of its refuse transfer stations.

The Athlone Refuse Transfer Station (ARTS), which has been in existence for eight years, has been revamped and reopened specifically to offer visitors an interactive educational experience in waste management, waste avoidance and responsible waste disposal. A visit to the ARTS offers educators and learners an insight into the waste stream journey.

Safety rules for visitors to the ARTS

Visits to the ARTS will take place under the guidance of trained staff. Since it is an operational site, it has stringent safety rules and regulations. All visitors will have to adhere to these rules, and sign an indemnity form.

- Wear closed, non-slip shoes.
- You will be issued with a bib. Wear it at all times, and return it after your tour of the plant.
- Stay in your group with your guide, and do not stray or run around.
- Listen to your guide.
