**REQUEST TO CONTRACT WITH ANOTHER ORGAN OF
STATE: DP6212: PROCUREMENT OF SPECIALISED
NUTRITION PRODUCTS FROM THE NATIONAL TREASURY
CONTRACT RT9-2017**

In response to questions raised regarding the expiry of the National Treasury Contract RT9-2017, Mr R White confirmed that the contract expires on 30 November 2020.

The Committee was of the view that it cannot make an award for a period exceeding the expiry of a contract.

Mr V Ninzi explained that the proposed contract period was linked to the extension of the RT contract by National Treasury.

Members of the Committee was of the view that all the requirements to piggy-back on the proposed contract RT9-2017 has not been met.

It was proposed that an award only be made up to the expiry of the contract on 30 November 2020 and that a further report be submitted for consideration once the National Treasury contract is renewed.

RESOLVED that for the reasons set out in the report and in accordance with clause 20.1 of the CCT's SCM Policy, the National Treasury be appointed in terms of Contract RT9-2017 for the Supply and delivery of specialised nutrition products as per the attached Circular: H18/2018 from date of award (14 September 2020) until 30 November 2020.
