

**RESOLUTIONS OF THE SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT BID ADJUDICATION

**SCMB 49/12/19 PROCUREMENT OF GOODS/SERVICES/CONSTRUCTION WORKS
FROM ANOTHER ORGAN OF STATE: COMMUNITY FACILITY
PLANNING 2040 FOR CAPE TOWN MUNICIPAL AREA**

The official confirmed that the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) has been doing similar work for the other Municipalities and National departments. She said that it was intended that the CSIR focus on schools and health planning together with the National departments and the City's Community Facilities department.

In response to questions raised regarding value for money and the comparison of cost in terms of the Cost Containment Regulations, the official said that in terms of cost comparison, the CSIR is performing similar work over a 3 year period for the eThekweni Municipality and Tshwane at an approximate contract sum of R6 million, but the quotation to the City was approximately R2 million for this work. She said that the intended work for the City has not been done anywhere else.

In response to the contract period for this work, the official explained that, although 12 months is recommended, it is intended that the work start from January 2020 until 30 June 2020 in terms of the current budget provision. The official said that part of this work is subject to the City Manager signing a MOU with the National Department of Public Works.

RESOLVED that for the reasons set out in the report and in accordance with clause 20.1 of the City's SCM Policy, the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) be appointed for Community Facility Planning 2040 in the amount of R1 904 440.25 (excl. VAT), from date of commencement of contract until 30 June 2020.
