

**RESOLUTIONS OF THE SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT BID ADJUDICATION
COMMITTEE: 22 OCTOBER 2018**

SCMB 90/10/18 PROCUREMENT OF GOODS/ SERVICES/ CONSTRUCTION FROM ANOTHER ORGAN OF STATE: AGREEMENT WITH TRANSNET SOC LTD (TRANSNET FREIGHT RAIL) TO PROVIDE SERVICES I.E. TRANSPORTATION OF CONTAINERISED "WASTE BY RAIL" BETWEEN ATHLONE REFUSE TRANSFER STATION (ARTS) AND VISSERSHOK LANDFILL SITE (VLFS)

In response to the question raised regarding the status of Section 33 of the MFMA process, the official confirmed that the line department will continue with the contract in terms of the Section 33 process approved by Council in August 2016. He said that the replacement contract has not been finalised.

RESOLVED that:

- (a) **RESOLVED** that for the reasons set out in the report and in accordance with Clause 20.1 of the Supply Chain Management Policy, the appointment of Transnet SOC Ltd to render the service for the transport of containerised waste by rail between Athlone Refuse Transfer Station (ARTS) and Vissershok Landfill Site (VLFS), at the same terms and conditions as the original contract, from date of commencement of contract until the replacement contract has been finalised, or until the Section 33 of the MFMA process has been finalised, not exceeding 30 June 2021, whichever occurs first, as follows (excl. VAT):

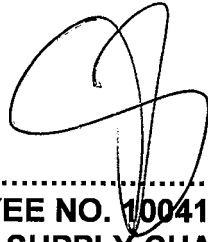
