

RESOLUTIONS OF THE SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT BID ADJUDICATION COMMITTEE: 31 MAY 2021

SCMB 125/05/21 PROCUREMENT OF GOODS/SERVICES/CONSTRUCTION WORKS FROM ANOTHER ORGAN OF STATE: APPOINTMENT OF THE CSIR TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATING TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF ELECTRICITY SUPPLY PATHWAYS FOR THE CITY OF CAPE TOWN

Members of the Committee through a BAC Comments from raised questions and comments.

The Chairperson requested that the commencement and expiry dates of the contract to be provided.

The contract duration was confirmed from 01 July 2021 until 30 June 2022, as the financial footnote only makes provision for funding up to 30 June 2022.

It was confirmed that recommendation "b" be excluded.

Mr R Naidoo advised that although the contract was requested for a period of 18 months in terms of conservatism in case of overruns, he confirmed that a 12-month period would cover the work.

Mr W Muller enquired whether the 12 months would still cost R1 880 060 (excl. VAT).

It was advised that the proposal by the bidders, attached to the report, shows a plan for 10 months of work and that is what the money covers. Assurance of value for money was provided.

The SCM practitioner, Mr G Williams confirmed that the recommended tenderer is tax compliant on CSD.

At the meeting of the 31st of May 2021, the committee resolved that Mr R Wootton be authorised to sign resolutions on behalf of the Chairperson while he is on leave

RESOLVED that for the reasons set out in the report and in accordance with clause 20.1 of the City's SCM Policy, the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research t/a WNNR/CSIR be appointed to deliver professional services for the development of a study on electricity supply pathways for the City of Cape Town, in the amount of R1 880,060.00 (excl. VAT), from 01 July 2021 until 30 June 2022.
