SCMB 11/03/19 PROCUREMENT OF GOODS/SERVICES/CONSTRUCTION WORKS FROM ANOTHER ORGAN OF STATE: APPOINTMENT OF THE WESTERN CAPE GOVERNMENT'S DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SETTLEMENTS, TO IMPLEMENT THE CONSTRUCTION OF CIVIL AND ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATING TO FOUR SUBSIDISED HOUSING PROJECTS

It was noted that some of the projects were initiated in the year 2015.

In response to questions raised regarding the Belhar-Pentech Project, the official confirmed that the decision to enter into a contract was made during the latter part of 2018.

RESOLVED that for the reasons set out in the report and in accordance with clause 20.1 of the CCT's SCM Policy, Western Cape Government's Department of Human Settlements be appointed for the construction of civil and electrical infrastructure from 01 April 2019 until 30 June 2021 on the following projects (excl. VAT), subject to the Memorandum of Agreement being fully signed by both parties, and any increase in the Housing Subsidy Quantum be passed on to the Western Cape Government on a pro rata basis, for those activities still to be completed:
