Mr S Glass advised that they would commence with a section 33 process to appoint SANRAL on a longer term contract.

RESOLVED that for the reasons set out in the report and in accordance with clause 20.1 of the City's SCM Policy, The SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL ROADS AGENCY SOC be appointed to operate and maintain the City of Cape Town's portion of the Cape Town Freeway Management System, in the operating expenditure amount of R2,436,402.54 (excl. VAT), from 01 July 2021 until 31 December 2021.
