Members of the Committee through a BAC Comments from raised questions and comments.

The Director: SCM was of the view that the City's contract term cannot exceed the RT Contract term set by National Treasury.

The officials responded that the transversal contract has been extended by National Treasury.

Members of the committee enquired whether the contract is between the City and National Treasury or between the City and the suppliers contracting with National Treasury.

The CFO representative, Mr J Steyl referred to the contract period in the recommendation and proposed that the date be corrected from 01 December 2020 until 31 March 2021. Mr Steyl also enquired whether the tender was rates based.

The Legal Adviser, Mr A Page indicated that the contract must be valid at the time of wanting to piggy back.

The Project Manager, Mr R White responded that the contract will be between the City and the suppliers contracting with National Treasury and that it is a rates-based contract and the estimated contract value is R6 548, 000.00. Mr White said that the costs are fully recoverable according to the signed Service Level Agreement (SLA) with Western Cape Government: Health (WCG:H). The City's Health department enters into an SLA agreement with WCG:H on an annual basis to provide Personal Primary Health Care (PPHC) services within its service delivery areas on behalf of WCG: H.

Members of the Committee felt that if it is a piggy-back contract there are certain criteria that needs to be met.

The Senior SCM Practitioner, Mr V Ninzi referred to clause 5 on page 16-17 of the report with regards to the Regulations 32 requirements.

It was requested that the names of the contractors to be used be included in the recommendation, Mr Ninzi was requested to



provide a memo listing the names of all the contractors. Mr Ninzi also confirmed National Treasury extended the contract until 31 March 2021.

RESOLVED that for the reasons set out in the report and in accordance with clause 67 of the CCT's SCM Policy, Abbott Laboratories SA (Pty) Ltd, At Life Products (Pty) Ltd, Energy Supplement CC, Fresenius Kabi South Africa (Pty) Ltd, Glucoseless (Pty)Ltd, Nativa (Pty) Ltd, Nestle South Africa (Pty), Nutricia Southern Africa (Pty) Ltd, Pharmacare Ltd t/a Aspen Pharmacare, Resaf Nutrition (Pty) Ltd, Sinapi Manufacturing (Pty) Ltd, Tempus Dynamics (Pty), Thembakonke project CC, Diva Nutritional Products (Pty) Ltd, Medtronic (Africa) (Pty) Ltd) be appointed for the Supply and delivery of specialised nutrition products in respect of the National Treasury Contract RT9-2017 tender as per Annexure F attached as Circular: H18/2018, from 01 December 2020 until 31 March 2021.
