Members of the Committee through a BAC Comments form raised questions and comments.

The Chairperson enquired why the % increase is so high and if there was a written confirmation. It was indicated that it is much higher than inflation, negative growth, etc.

The officials responded that the percentage increase is an estimation as they cannot determine the price increase prior to submission of the report, also the College cannot provide us with a confirmed price increase % as they are dependent on the RTMC to provide them with this once they meet prior to their new financial start in April. Thus far the price increase has varied between 5-7% increase.

Mr B Davids referred to Annexure C and advised that the tariffs are fixed for the 21/22 year.

It was confirmed that recommendation "c" be amended to read: prices to be adjusted according the RMTT annual price increase.
