PROVIDE SUMMARY OF HOST ORGANISATION / CITY
The Twelfth Session of the World Urban Forum WUF12, convened by the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat), took place in Cairo, Egypt, from 4 to 8 November 2024, returning to the African continent after more than 20 years after its inception in Nairobi, Kenya, in 2002.

4. OBJECTIVE

The workshop session attended was entitled 'Planning in Crisis: A Food Water Energy Nexus Approach to Resilience,' co-convened by ICLEI Africa, Utrecht University, Resilient Cities Network and World Resources Institute. It was an interactive session promoting mutual learning between participating cities and urban actors.

Participation in this conference and session offered value for the City in the form of peer exchange on experiences that global South cities have faced in responding to emerging resource crises. It allowed for the City of Cape Town's learnings to be shared around how the Water-Energy-Food (WEF) nexus approach can enhance urban resilience, and how CCT is undertaking future planning, while having to respond to immediate crises. The session documented innovative strategies from multiple cities addressing crises in water, energy, food and waste systems, all in the context of global polycrises.

5. OUTCOMES

While attending the World Urban Forum, Kayleen Simpson together with Alderman Jean-Pierre Smith, presented to a judging panel for the Liveable Communities (LivCom) Award. Cape Town was awarded 2nd Place Gold award in the Whole City category for liveability and quality of life.

9. GENERAL DISCUSSION

Cape Town has earned a prestigious second-place Gold award at the 2024 Liveable Communities (LivCom) Awards, a global competition that recognizes cities for their efforts in creating vibrant, sustainable, and inclusive communities. The city secured this recognition in the category for cities with populations over 400,000, further cementing its reputation as a global leader in urban sustainability and quality of life.

The 2024 LivCom Awards saw fierce competition, with 33 cities from 30 countries vying for the top spots. A total of 39 innovative projects were presented to the judging panel, which evaluated each city based on how they improved the lives of their residents through sustainable practices. These projects were assessed across six key criteria:

1. Enhancement of Landscapes and Public Spaces
 2. Arts, Culture, and Heritage Management
 3. Environmental Protection and Green Economy
 4. Community Participation and Empowerment
 5. Healthy Lifestyle
 6. Sustainable Planning and Management Policies
