6.2			The Chief Fire Officer in consultation with the Executive Director: Safety and Security, may agree to make concessions to charges up to 25% provided the following criteria were met:							
	6.2.1		Where a fire is detected by an approved fire detection system and the alarm is transmitted to the Fire Service promptly.							
	6.2.2		Where a fire is prevented from spreading or is extinguished by an approved fixed fire fighting system.							
			The above reductions will only be permitted where no unsafe conditions or practises exist on the premises in question and provided that the system and equipment have been maintained to the satisfaction of the Chief Fire Officer.							
6.3			The Executive Director: Safety and Security may on the recommendation of the Chief Fire Officer make concessions to attendance and operational charges by up to 80% where a fire or related services have been rendered to <i>bona fide</i> charitable organisations. In formulating the recommendation, the Chief Fire Officer shall take into consideration the exigencies of the service at the time of the incident; the distance from the nearest available resources; the condition of the premises regarding fire fighting equipment, emergency exits and the management of fire hazards; the extent to which damage could not be prevented by the Fire & Rescue Service; the frequency of similar occurrences on the same premises or any other relevant factor.							
6.4			The Executive Director: Safety and Security may on the recommendation of the Chief Fire Officer make concessions to the attendance and operational charges by up to 50% where a fire or related services have been rendered to (1) a school which is classified as a Class A3 building in terms of Table 1 of SABS 0400-1990 "the Code of Practice for the Application of the National Building Regulations" and which is used as a place of learning for Grades 1 - 12 and (2) a place of Worship which is Classified as a Class A4 building in terms of Table 1 of SABS 0400 - 1990. In formulating the recommendation the Chief Fire Officer shall take into consideration the exigencies of the service at the time of the incident; the distance from the nearest available resources; the condition of the premises regarding firefighting equipment, emergency exits and the management of fire hazards; the extent to which damage could not be prevented by the Fire & Rescue Service; the frequency of similar occurrences on the same premises or any other relevant factor.							
6.5			The Executive Director: Safety and Security may, on the recommendation of the Chief Fire Officer, agree not to charge for the attendance and operational charges where a fire or related service has been rendered to a Department (SANPark's) that renders a fire fighting service within the boundaries of the City of Cape Town. In return SANParks will not raise any charges for any similar service rendered to the City and will allow the City's two dedicated aerial support choppers to be accommodated in terms of standby for 6 months of the high fire season at Newlands SANpark base. The Chief Fire Officer shall take into consideration the exigencies of the service at the time of the incident; the distance from the nearest available resources regarding firefighting equipment and the management of fire hazards; the extent to which damage could not be prevented by the Fire & Rescue Service; the frequency of similar occurrences on the same premises or any other relevant factor and that same Department not invoice/bill the Fire & Rescue Service for similar fire fighting services rendered by the City of Cape Town.							
6.6			The Chief Fire Officer in consultation with the Executive Director: Safety and Security consider a reduction of charges up to a maximum of 50% for all written applications.							
6.7			The Executive Director in consultation with the respective departmental heads may reduce all tariffs and fees as approved by Council for this Directorate up to a maximum of 50% of the actual amounts to be billed. All applications for such reduction to be submitted in writing to the office of the Executive Director: Safety and Security. All decisions made in terms of such authority to be reported to the Office of the City Manager.

6.8	The Executive Director: Safety and Security may on the recommendation of the Chief Fire Officer make concessions to the attendance and operational charges by up to 50% where a fire or related services have been rendered to registered FPA's on condition that they apply for reduction for services rendered and the attending Incident Commander confirms that the property has been maintained in accordance with the National Veld and Forest Fire Act, Act no 101 of 1998 (NVFFA). Owners of property where a veld fire could occur are obliged to take certain measures to prevent such fires and failing that, to minimise their effect. The reduction will only be considered once the Chief Fire Officer has confirmed registration and compliance to the Veld and Forest Act.									
6.9	A tariff shall be imposed relating to any fire in an exempted category wherever there is evidence of illegal building work, land use or building development violations, subletting in violation of lease conditions or subletting in the case of council rental units, illegal electrical connections or a failure to effect fire breaks between structures or vegetation unless good cause is shown by the owner that measures were taken to prevent the illegal occupation or fire risk

	Incident Group - definitions									
	Incident group 1 : No charge is levied for this category . Residential properties owned by a person, MVA's including persons trapped, any rescue including high angle swift water diving incidents, medical and trauma.									
	Incident group 2 : Low risk – For this category there is a basic levy raised for businesses and trusts. The levy is charged from time of vehicles arriving on scene until departure. The cost is calculated per 15mins or part thereof for example a pump which is a frontline response vehicle to any incident as it is equipped to handle any emergency which includes the vehicle and personnel including veld fires. On arrival at the incident the incident commander can call for further assistance depending what specialized vehicle is required. In the case when a caller has given sufficient information in terms of what is the exact circumstances of the incident for example a high rise building alight, various vehicles will respond to this incident i.e. two pumps, a hydraulic platform, water tanker. On arrival the incident commander will request for further specialized vehicles once he is aware of what he is dealing with.									
	Incident group 3 : Moderate risk category – This category is levied at storage facilities heavy duty horse and trailers vehicles transporting goods as well as when we are dealing with a structure fire more than three stories. This would include hotels and boarding houses. In these types of fires a lot more vehicles and personnel are required as breathing apparatus would definitely be used and Fire Services would conduct search and rescue throughout the premises to ascertain if any person have been overcome by smoke (which is termed as smoke inhalation)									
	Incident group 4 : High Risk Category - This category is levied dealing with high risk incidents, chemical factories, paint factories, petrol chemical. Where we are required to use various types of foam to suppress hydro carbon and poly carbon fires and the risk of fighting this fire poses a greater threat to personnel.									
	Incident group 5 : High Risk Category which includes aircraft and ships.									
	Mutual Aid - is the agreement between the City and Districts outside the boundaries of the City at the District and National level.
