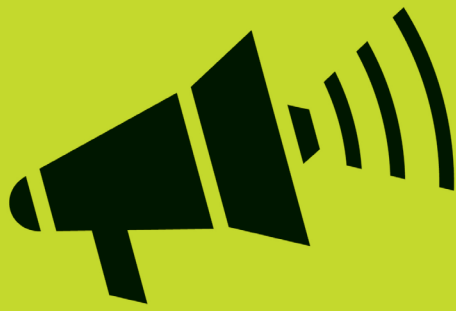




PUBLIC NOTICE: STORMWATER PIPELINE REHABILITATION IN GREEN POINT

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate hereby advises the public of stormwater rehabilitation in Green Point at the corner of Wigtown Road and Haytor Road, extending south towards the cul-de-sac near the rear entrance of Reddam House. This forms part of regular maintenance to alleviate flooding issues and to prolong the longevity of the city's stormwater infrastructure network.

The work is planned to take place from Monday 23 March 2026 until Thursday 16 July 2026 between 07:00 and 17:00, Monday to Friday. Residents and business owners can expect some noise during this time.

Please note that:

- The above-mentioned dates can change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Traffic moving in both directions will be affected
- Flag personnel will direct traffic through temporary detours around the work area
- Work areas will be demarcated to regulate traffic flow
- Vehicles parked in the road and obstructing the maintenance work, will be moved or towed

Road users are urged to:

- Be cautious while work is underway
- Lower your speed
- Pay attention to road signs
- Be vigilant in and around the roadworks area
- Look out for uneven road surfaces
- Be mindful of the construction workers
- Factor in longer travel time

Congestion is expected, so it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.

OPENBARE KENNISGEWING: **REHABILITASIE VAN STORMWATERPYPLYN IN GROENPUNT**

Die Stad Kaapstad se direktoraat stedelike mobiliteit stel die publiek hiermee in kennis van die rehabilitasie van 'n stormwaterpyplyn in Groenpunt op die hoek van Wigtown- en Haytorweg, suidwaarts in die rigting van die doodloopstraat naby Reddam House se agterste ingang. Dit maak deel uit van gereelde instandhouding om oorstromingsprobleme te verlig en die lewensduur van die stad se stormwaterinfrastruktuursnetwerk te verleng.

Die werk sal volgens beplanning van Maandag 23 Maart 2026 tot Donderdag 16 Julie 2026, Maandag tot Vrydag tussen 07:00 en 17:00, gedoen word. Inwoners en sake-eienaars kan 'n mate van geraas gedurende hierdie tyd te wagte wees.

- Die bogenoemde datums weens onvoorsiene omstandighede kan verander
- Verkeer in beide rigtings geraak sal word
- Vlagpersoneel die verkeer met tydelike ompaaie rondom die werksgebied sal herlei
- Werksgebiede tydelik afgebaken sal word om verkeersvloei te reguleer
- Voertuie wat in die pad geparkeer is en die werk belemmer, verskuif of weggesleep sal word

- Versigtig te wees terwyl die werk aan die gang is
- Hul snelheid te verminder
- Aan padtekens aandag te gee
- Waaksaam binne en rondom die padwerkegebied te wees
- Op ongelyke padoppervlakke bedag te wees
- Konstruksiewerkers in ag te neem
- Vir langer reistyd voorsiening te maak
