



PUBLIC NOTICE: BRIDGE REHABILITATION IN BROOKLYN AND MILNERTON

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate advises the public of the rehabilitation of the Zoarvlei wooden pedestrian bridge in Brooklyn and the Loxton Road bridge in Milnerton. This forms part of regular maintenance to ensure the longevity and safety of the city's bridge network.

The work is planned to take place from Friday 1 May 2026 until Tuesday 1 December 2026 between 07:00 and 17:00, Monday to Saturday. Residents and business owners can expect some noise during this time.

Please note that:

- The above-mentioned dates can change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Traffic moving in both directions will be affected
- Flag personnel will direct traffic through temporary detours around the work area
- Work areas will be demarcated to regulate traffic flow
- Vehicles parked in the road and obstructing the maintenance work, will be moved or towed

Road users are urged to:

- Be cautious while work is underway
- Lower your speed
- Pay attention to road signs
- Be vigilant in and around the roadworks area
- Look out for uneven road surfaces
- Be mindful of the construction workers
- Factor in longer travel time

Congestion is expected, so it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.

OPENBARE KENNISGEWING: BRUGREHABILITASIE IN BROOKLYN EN MILNERTON

Die Stad Kaapstad se direktoraat stedelike mobiliteit stel die publiek in kennis van die rehabilitasie van die Zoarvlei-houtvoetbrug in Brooklyn en die Loxtonweg-brug in Milnerton. Dit maak deel uit van gereelde instandhouding om die lewensduur en veiligheid van die stad se brugnetwerk te verleng.

- Verkeer in beide rigtings geraak sal word
- Vlagpersoneel die verkeer met tydelike ompaaie rondom die werksgebied sal herlei
- Werksgebiede tydelik afgebaken sal word om verkeersvloei te reguleer
- Voertuie wat in die pad geparkeer is en die werk belemmer, verskuif of weggesleep sal word

- Versigtig te wees terwyl die werk aan die gang is
- Hul snelheid te verminder
- Aan padtekens aandag te gee
- Waaksaam binne en rondom die padwerkegebied te wees
- Op ongelyke padoppervlakke bedag te wees
- Konstruksiewerke in ag te neem
- Vir langer reistyd voorsiening te maak
