



PUBLIC NOTICE: ROADWORKS IN CAPE TOWN

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate hereby advises the public of repairs to the pedestrian bridge across Strand Street, between the Cape Town Station taxi deck and the Golden Arrow bus station in the CBD. This project is necessary to enhance pedestrian safety.

The work is planned to take place from Monday 2 March 2026 until Monday 31 August 2026 between 06:00 and 19:00, Monday to Saturday, weather permitting and provided there are no unforeseen delays. Residents and business owners can expect some noise during this time.

Please note that:

- The above-mentioned dates can change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Traffic moving in both directions will be affected
- Flag personnel will direct traffic through temporary detours around the work area
- Work areas will be demarcated to regulate traffic flow
- Vehicles parked in the road and obstructing the maintenance work, will be moved or towed

Road users are urged to:

- Be cautious while work is underway
- Lower your speed
- Pay attention to road signs
- Be vigilant in and around the roadworks area
- Look out for uneven road surfaces
- Be mindful of the construction workers
- Factor in longer travel time

Congestion is expected, so it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.

OPENBARE KENNISGEWING: PADWERKE IN KAAPSTAD

Die Stad Kaapstad se direktoraat stedelike mobiliteit stel die publiek hiermee in kennis van herstelwerk aan die voetgangerbrug oor Strandstraat, tussen die Kaapstadse stasiedek en die Golden Arrow-bushalte in die middestad. Hierdie projek is nodig vir groter voetgangerveiligheid.

Die werk sal volgens beplanning vanaf Maandag 2 Maart 2026 tot Maandag 31 Augustus 2026 duur, tussen 0600 en 19:00 van Maandag tot Saterdag, afhangende van die weer en mits daar geen onvoorsiene vertraging is nie. Inwoners en sake-eienaars kan 'n mate van geraas gedurende hierdie tyd te wagte wees.

- Die bogenoemde datums weens onvoorsiene omstandighede kan verander
- Verkeer in beide rigtings geraak sal word
- Vlagpersoneel die verkeer met tydelike ompaaie rondom die werksgebied sal herlei
- Werksgebiede tydelik afgebaken sal word om verkeersvloei te reguleer
- Voertuie wat in die pad geparkeer is en die werk belemmer, verskuif of weggesleep sal word

- Versigtig te wees terwyl die werk aan die gang is
- Hul snelheid te verminder
- Aan padtekens aandag te gee
- Waaksaam binne en rondom die padwerkegebied te wees
- Op ongelyke padoppervlakke bedag te wees
- Konstruksiewerkers in ag te neem
- Vir langer reistyd voorsiening te maak
