



# PUBLIC NOTICE: ROADWORKS IN WELLWAY PARK EAST, DURBANVILLE

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate hereby advises the public of roadworks along segments of Tambotie Crescent, Primula Avenue, Lobelia Road, Dahlia Close, Cyclamen Road, Camelia Way and Tamarisk Street in Wellway Park East, Durbanville. This forms part of regular maintenance to prolong the longevity of the city's road network.

The work is planned to take place from Monday 27 July 2026 until Thursday 12 November 2026 between 09:00 and 15:30, Monday to Friday, weather permitting and provided there are no unforeseen delays. Residents and business owners can expect some noise during this time.

**Please note that:**

- The above-mentioned dates can change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Traffic moving in both directions will be affected
- Flag personnel will direct traffic through temporary detours around the work area
- Work areas will be demarcated to regulate traffic flow
- Vehicles parked in the road and obstructing the maintenance work, will be moved or towed

**Road users are urged to:**

- Be cautious while work is underway
- Lower your speed
- Pay attention to road signs
- Be vigilant in and around the roadworks area
- Look out for uneven road surfaces
- Be mindful of the construction workers
- Factor in longer travel time

**Congestion is expected, so it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.**
