

BE FLOOD-WISE!

MOPPING UP

- Stay out of your home if flood water remains deep around it.
- When re-entering your home, be careful because the structure might be in danger of collapsing.
- NEVER use an electric appliance while standing in water!
- Wash all surfaces that came into contact with flood water with soapy water.
- Then disinfect the surfaces with a mixture of two teaspoons of bleach in a bucket of water. If the surfaces are rough, scrub them with a brush.



PROTECT YOUR HEALTH

Flood water can make you sick. Rather be safe than sorry!

- Tell children not to play in flood water.
- Beware of sharp objects in the water.
- Wash your hands with soap and clean water before working with food.
- Wash children's hands frequently.
- If food or medicine has come in contact with flood water, throw it away.
