Dust To Dust

The first mausoleum dates back to 353 BC and the death of King Maussollos of Persia.

While modern public mausoleums reflect its building-shaped style, they now use activated carbon ventilation systems to neutralise odours and promote rapid decomposition of mortal remains. It has the least environmental impact of current burial options.

Above-ground burials

Mausoleums

- Ideal where land is limited or water-saturated
- Includes 144 crypts
- Easy to keep clean
- Secure
- Odour-free
- Niche boxes for ash remains

Above-ground crypts

- Mimic in-ground graves
- Built where digging graves is difficult
- Can hold two coffins
