

ORGANIC WASTE DIVERSION PROJECT

Thank you for participating in this trial to investigate possible waste diversion opportunities together with the City of Cape Town.

As participant you will receive:

- A 5 litre plastic bucket/container, and
- A list of what can be put into the container (see below).

In return, you will be required to:

- Place your organic waste in the provided 5 litre container. This could be stored inside your fridge until it is full and then handed over to the project team on collection day **THIS COULD BE STORED INSIDE YOUR FRIDGE UNTIL IT IS FULL AND KEPT FOR COLLECTION DAY BY THE PROJECT TEAM.**
- The 5 litre container will be emptied, cleaned and returned to you (ready to be filled again).



Acceptable organic waste to put into your 5 litre plastic container:

1. Fruit and vegetable scraps
2. Eggshells
3. Tea bags
4. Vacuum cleaner contents
5. Food scraps (rice, pap, sauce, pasta, meat, bones, fish and chicken bones)
6. Serviettes

Unacceptable waste NOT to put into your 5 litre plastic container:

NO food containers (plastic/metal and similar packaging)
