Purpose of a Social Compact - Why?

- It allows people and groups to work together to achieve a common goal or derive mutual benefits;
- Understanding that different roleplayers may have different interests
- Outlines the rights and responsibilities of participants;
- Creates common ground for future associations;
- To create better and faster results;
- To share the skills between participants;
- Avoid uncertainties down the line, by clarifying the nature and scope of your relationship.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

Local Spatial Framework – development vision for the area that:

- addresses the needs of all stakeholders;
- Provides a vibrant living environment;
- Includes all aspects of an integrated community – housing, business, open spaces, movement, social facilities;
- Creates a link between the CBD and other areas of the City;
- Joint ownership of final plan

Community Building and Engagement

PRINCIPLES OF ENGAGEMENT

- Complete transparency and openness – sharing information;
- Mutual respect for opinions;
- All opinions and inputs to be considered, but compromise may be necessary;
- Participation to include displaced community and include broader Cape Town community;
- Information to be in user friendly format - limit technical jargon and acronyms;
- Where possible, physical meetings and events to take place in the area;
- Project Management principles to be followed with focus on implementation – projects to be realistic and implementable

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Local Government

- Manage process and guide discussions;
- Provide forums and platforms to enable participation and inputs;
- Share Information;
- Draft proposals;
- Formal Adoption of the plan;
- Develop implementation plan;
- Budget for projects;
- Implementation

Community

- Share information;
- Inform other community members;
- Ensure fair, inclusive participation;
- Provide input and proposals – co-planning;
- Assist with implementation;
- Monitor and provide feedback
