MOTION IN TERMS OF RULE 18 OF THE RULES OF ORDER FOR COUNCIL FOR THE SCHEDULED COUNCIL MEETING ON 08 DECEMBER 2022

I, Linda Mazwi, hereby table a motion in terms of Rule 18 of the Rules of Order of Council as amended by Council on 05 December 2019 C19/12/19 table the following motion:

Noting that:

- Section 27 of the Constitution, clearly states that, “Everyone has the right to have access to health care services, including reproductive health care.”
- Clinics are the most accessible health centres for the majority of the people in townships and in areas inhabited by the poor.
- Many of the ailments and many of the accidents that require urgent medical care take place after normal working hours

Believing that:

- The right to have access to health care services is a basic human right guaranteed by the Constitution.
- The City has the capacity and the resources to extend the operational hours of all clinics within its jurisdiction
- There is a desperate need for health services to be accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week across the City.
- The rights to health care includes pregnant women who are legible for termination of pregnancy service in accordance with the choice of Termination Act 92 of 1996
- These facilities must not just open but operate and service the poorest of the poor communities that are over populated to carb the gap of the Provincial Health Care centres that are unable to accommodate more people
- The few remaining City of Cape Town Health care centres can be of use and help these communities and making sure that people if Cape Town are being served and attended every time of the day.

Recommend that:

- Council resolves to have all health facilities under the City of Cape Town to open twenty four hours a day, seven days a week.

- That the relevant department working with the department of social development undertakes to conduct a feasibility assessment and operational requirements for putting this resolution into effect
- That the relevant department reports to Council by March 2023.

Ek, Linda Mazwi, lê hiermee 'n mosie ter tafel ingevolge reël 18 van die Raad se ordereëls soos gewysig deur die Raad op 5 Desember 2019 (C19/12/19):

Met kennisname dat:

- Artikel 27 van die Grondwet duidelik meld: “Elkeen het die reg op toegang tot-gesondheidsorgdienste, met inbegrip van reprodktiewe gesondheidsorg.”
- Klinieke die toeganklikste gesondheidsentrums is vir die meeste mense in townships en op plekke wat deur die armes bewoon word.
- Baie van die siektes en baie van die ongelukke wat dringende mediese sorg vereis, na normale werksure plaasvind.

Met die siening dat:

- Die reg tot toegang tot gesondheidsorgdienste is 'n basiese mensereg wat deur die Grondwet gewaarborg word.
- Die Stad het die kapasiteit en die hulpbronne om die bedryfsure van alle klinieke binne sy regsgebied te verleng.
- Daar is 'n desperate behoefte aan die beskikbaarheid van gesondheidsdienste 24 uur van die dag, sewe dae van die week regdeur die stad.
- Die regte tot gesondheidsorg sluit in swanger vroue wat in aanmerking kom vir die diens vir die beëindiging van hul swangerskap in ooreenstemming met die Wet op Keuse van Beëindiging van Swangerskap, Wet 92 van 1996.
- Hierdie fasiliteite moet nie net oop wees nie maar werk en die gemeenskappe van die armstes van die armes wat oorbevolk is, bedien om die leemte te vul wat gelaat word deur die provinsiale gesondheidsentrums wat nie vir nog meer mense voorsiening kan maak nie.

- Die paar oorblywende Stad Kaapstad-gesondheidsorgsentrusms kan van nut wees en hierdie gemeenskappe help en seker maak dat mense van Kaapstad te alle tye bedien word en aandag ontvang.

Aanbeveel dat:

- Die Raad besluit om alle gesondheidsfasiliteite onder die Stad Kaapstad 24 per uur per dag, sewe dae per week oop te stel.
- Die betrokke departement wat saam met die departement maatskaplike ontwikkeling werk, onderneem om 'n uitvoerbaarheidsassessering te doen en bedryfsvereistes daarstel om hierdie resoluie uit te voer.
