4. DISCUSSION

The Street People Programme Unit (SPPU) Area teams engage people living on the street through daily outreach activities and social interventions, particularly at hotspot areas across the City. Standardised screening forms are utilised to record engagements and the participation of people living on the street is voluntary. Offers of social assistance are often declined. However, SD & ECD continues engagements with people living on the street up to a maximum of six times. As per the current Combined Working Agreement with Safety and Security, cases are handed over to Law Enforcement post SD & ECD interventions to implement the Streets, Public Places and Prevention of Noise Nuisances Amendment By-Law, 2021. No SD & ECD staff accompany Law Enforcement on 'clean-up' operations.

This report serves to provide the Committee with an update on the hotspot interventions for March 2022 and planning for April-June 2022, post the lifting of the COVID-19 Regulations.

AREA NORTH

Below is a list of hotspots identified for intervention between March and June 2022, to support the enforcement of the STREETS, PUBLIC PLACES AND PREVENTION OF NOISE NUISANCES AMENDMENT BY-LAW. One hundred and forty two (142) hotspots were identified for Area North.
