4. DISCUSSION

This report seeks approval from Council for the hand-over of the services rendered at the Protea Park and Saxon Sea clinics to the Western Cape Provincial Health and Wellness Department.

On the 16th August 2022, a memorandum from a group called ACHO (Atlantis Community Health Organisation) was handed over to the MEC for Health: Nomafrench Mbombo. The memorandum contained a number of demands and amongst others, was that the Western Cape Government: Health and Wellness to take over Protea Park and Saxon Sea clinics in Atlantis area. Subsequently, a task team was established of officials from City Health, Western Cape Government: Health Wellness and the representatives of the Atlantis Community Health Organisation was established to address this matter.

Various meetings were held with this community on 9th September, 28th September, 7th October, 4th November, and 13th December 2022. Discussions were held regarding the unfortunate patient experiences and concerns due to the fragmentation of health services. However, interim measures were put in place at Protea Park and Saxon Sea clinics to see stable chronic clients with the aim of decongesting the Westfleur hospital.

Following the announcement by the MEC for Health to the Atlantis community on the 29th August 2022, that the 2 (two) facilities must be handed over to the province within 36 months, the Metro Health Services (MHS) of the Western Cape Government Department of Health & Wellness indicated its intentions to commence with the process of transferring these facilities to the province. As, City Health is unable to provide the services demanded by ACHO, the Executive Director: Community Services and Health supports this initiative, subject to approval by Council.

If approved, it is envisaged that a transfer agreement will be entered into between the Western Cape Government: Health and Wellness and the City of Cape Town, and that the property will be sold to the Western Cape Government: Health and Wellness in line with the Municipal Finance and Management Act 2003 and the Municipal Assets and Transfer Regulation of 2008. While the bulk of the movable assets will be retained by City Health, for use in its other facilities, the negotiations for any such assets required to be transferred to the Western Cape Government: Health and Wellness on a monetary value, will also be part of the transfer agreement.

The staff currently working in the two (2) facilities will be redeployed at other City Health facilities after relevant consultation with each staff member.
