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4. DISCUSSION

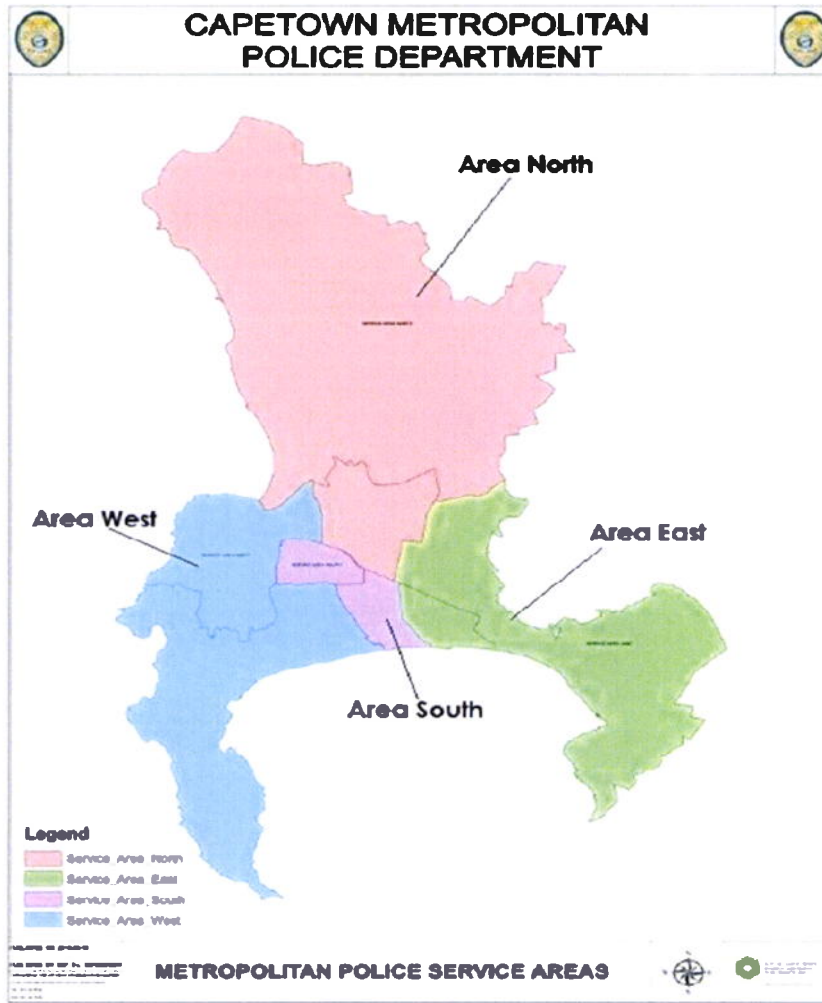


Figure 1: shows the four area model comprising the jurisdiction of Cape Town Metropolitan Police Department. Each operational area/Section averages 77 members per area. A total of 386 operational members are deployed across entire City of Cape Town geographical area of 2,461 km² with a population of 3, 740,026 Million (Ratio 1:9689).

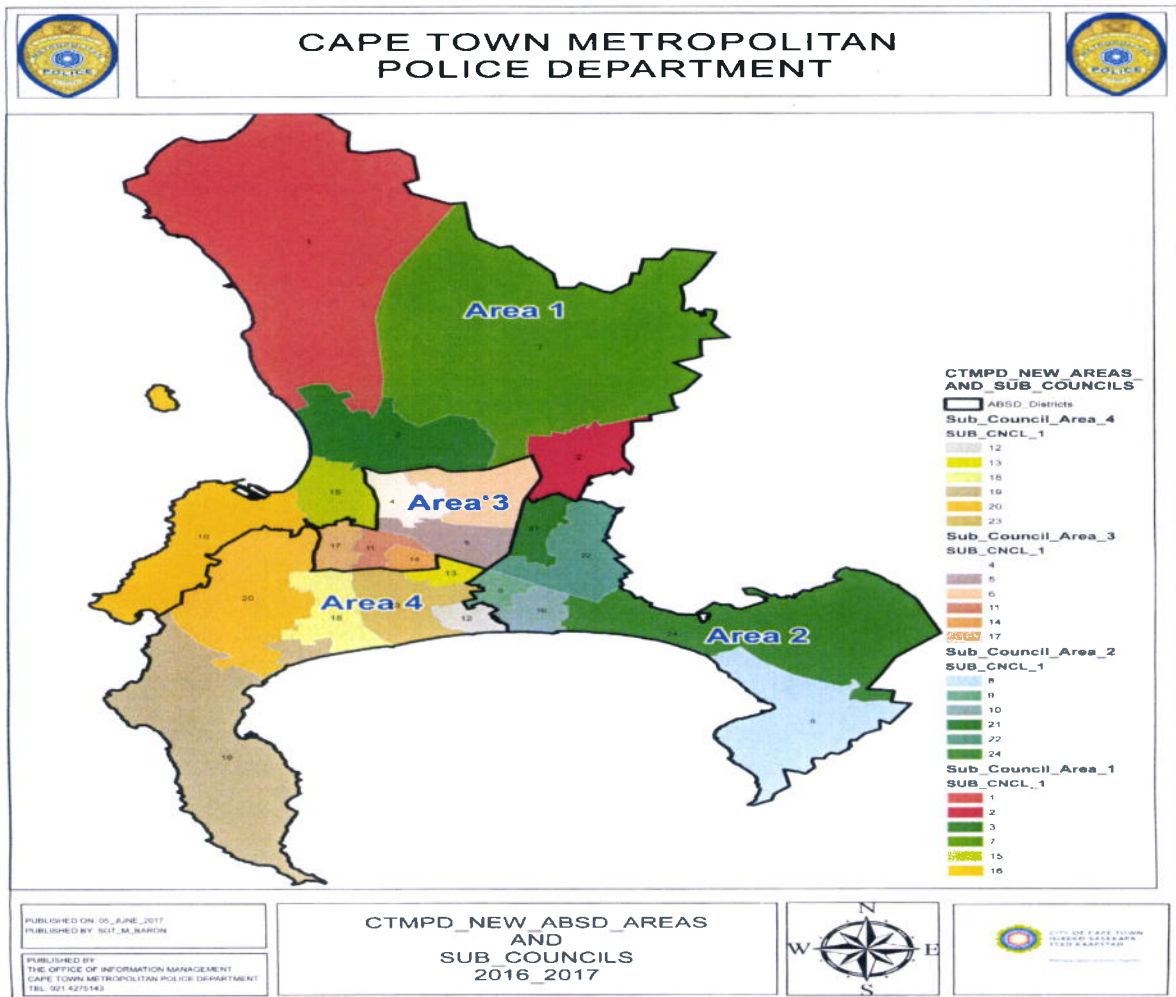
4.1 New ODTP Areas:
