4. DISCUSSION

In 2020 a Recovery Programme was put in place, to guide the response to the economic and other impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. A foundational component of this recovery programme was to develop an Infrastructure Planning and Delivery Framework.

Making progress possible. Together.

An initial detailed proposal for the Infrastructure Planning and Delivery Framework was presented to the Executive Management Team (EMT) and the Mayco Caucus in December 2020, where it received support for further development. The draft strategy and highlights of the 10-year portfolio have been presented in May to the EMT and in June to Mayco Caucus, where they received support.

The Infrastructure Planning and Delivery Framework was presented at a special Corporate Service PC workshop on the 23rd June, to which all PCs were invited. One of the resolutions from that workshop was that the other Section 79 Portfolio Committees be offered an opportunity for a presentation of the Framework to allow for further engagement with the content.

Attached to this report is a presentation summarising the Infrastructure Planning and Delivery Framework.

There is strong economic case for appropriate and effective infrastructure investment as a primary lever to support post-COVID-19 economic recovery. Likewise, there is a strong case for prioritising infrastructure development to support excellence in basic service delivery and to address systemic backlogs.

The Infrastructure Planning and Delivery Framework, and associated 10-year project portfolio, provides the City with a planning and delivery support mechanism to respond to long standing strategic priorities, as captured in various Council adopted and endorsed strategies, and to support post-pandemic recovery.

The Infrastructure Planning and Delivery Framework is attached as Annexure A. In summary the various components are as follows:

- Case for the Infrastructure Framework, including its purpose, objectives and scope
- Role as an administrative framework, to support the implementation of infrastructure by line departments
- Overview of capacity enhancements for infrastructure planning and delivery across the City and of existing planning instruments
- Method for portfolio selection, prioritisation and analysis
- Enablers of the Infrastructure Framework
 - Regulatory Reform
 - Advocacy Approach

It is to be noted by all PCs that the final Infrastructure Planning and Delivery Framework will be submitted to Council at its August Council meeting.
