To decide on an application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6(1) of the City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013

SubCouncil in terms of Delegation 4(2)

To approve, refuse or vary applications for extension of trading hours on premises where liquor licences have been granted.

4. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013, was promulgated on 17 January and coming into effect on 01 February 2014.

An application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6 (1) of the By-law was submitted to the Health Directorate and circulated to the relevant departments for comment. The fully signed application, including all required comments, was submitted to the SubCouncil 16 Manager, and was then circulated to abutting neighbours, all organisations included on the Ward 115 database and ward committee members for comment.

Clause 9 of the By-law requires that the City must, before approving an application for the extension of trading days and hours, reasonably and fairly consider further factors which must include, inter alia-

- (a) the validity of the liquor licence;
- (b) where applicable, the validity of a business licence issued in terms of the Businesses Act of 1991 (Act No. 71 of 1991);

- (c) location category as per the Schedule;
- (d) previous suspension, amendment or revocation of extended trading days and hours including previous records of complaints investigated and confirmed in respect of the last twelve months preceding a current application for extension;
- (e) the proximity of the licensed premises to surrounding residential zoned area, cultural, religious and educational facilities;
- (f) outcome of community consultation and the recommendation of the relevant ward:
- (g) the potential impact on the surrounding environment;
- (h) whether it is in the public interest to approve and grant an extension of trading days or hours; or
- (i) a motivation from the applicant dealing with the impact of
 - (i) the risks to and nuisances on the surrounding community;
 - (ii) mitigation measures to assist the control of risks and nuisances; and
 - (iii) possible benefits of extended liquor trading hours and days on the surrounding community.
- (10) The basis and rationale behind all decision-making must be recorded.

5. DISCUSSION

- 5.1 Section 6 (1) of the By-Law reads as follows:
 6(1) Subject to subsection (5), (6) and (7) a licensee may upon payment of the required fee, submit a written application to the City to extend the liquor trading days and hours of licensed premises.

The Applicant is:

Woolworths (Pty) Ltd, registration number 1956/000518/07, with registered address at Woolworths House, 93 Longmarket Street, Cape Town, 8001 and its postal address at P.O. Box 680, Cape Town, 8000.

The sole shareholder of the Applicant is:

Woolworths Holdings Limited (Registration No. 05/01986/06), a public company with limited liability whose shares are quoted on The Johannesburg Stock Exchange. The registered office of Woolworths Holdings Limited is at c/o Woolworths House, 93 Longmarket Street, Cape Town and its postal address is P.O. Box 680, Cape Town 8000.

ANNEXURE B - Form 3

The Western Cape Liquor Act was approved after widespread public participation and it is submitted that it reflects the will of the people of the Western Cape.

The Western Cape Act provides for licence holders with off-consumption liquor licenses to sell liquor on Sunday (in areas where the municipality had not promulgated a bylaw regulating liquor trading days and hours).

It is submitted that the Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public Bylaw of the City of Cape Town reflects the will of the citizens of Cape Town.

The Bylaw provides for licence holders with off-consumption liquor licenses to apply for Sunday trading.

Due to their working hours (also on weekends) and other commitments a significant percentage of the applicant's customers find it very difficult to purchase liquor weekdays and Saturdays.

Many of the Applicant's customers nowadays also choose to do their shopping on Sunday when they are not involved in the school activities of their children or their own sporting or social activities.

An amendment of the trading hours for the Applicant's store to include Sunday trading will allow them to purchase liquor with other products.

THE PROXIMITY OF LICENSED PREMISES TO SURROUNDING RESIDENTIAL ZONED AREA, CULTURE, RELIGIOUS AND EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES

The manner in which the business is carried on under the current trading hours does not prejudice the residents of a residential area or the proceedings in cultural, religious or educational facilities and it is submitted that there is no reason why Sunday trading will change this situation.

THE POTENTIAL IMPACT ON THE SURROUNDING ENVIRONMENT

The current activities of the applicant do not have any negative impact on the surrounding environment and it is submitted there is no reason why Sunday trading will change this situation.

THE RISKS TO AND NUISANCES ON THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY

The current activities of the applicant do not pose a risk or nuisance to the surrounding community and it is submitted there is no reason why Sunday trading will change this situation.

MITIGATION MEASURES TO ASSIST THE CONTROL OF RISKS AND NUISANCES

The applicant submits that its current activities do not cause risk or nuisance to the surrounding community.

No mitigation measures are therefore required.

However, should the applicant become aware of any risk or nuisance in future it will implement suitable measures to mitigate the risk or nuisance.

PUBLIC INTEREST

The proposed amendment to include Sunday trading will improve the shopping experience of the public by allowing customers time to purchase liquor on Sunday should this be the most convenient day for them.
