REPLY FROM THE EXECUTIVE MAYOR TO QUESTION FROM CLLR D COTTEE FOR COUNCIL MEETING ON 26 MAY 2016

- 1. After the non performing contractor was fired a new procurement plan has been prepared with SCM guidance. Should there be no appeals, a contractor is planned to be appointed by September 2016.
- 2. In terms of the procurement plan and progress of civil contractor, the top structure tender is planned to be advertised in October 2016. Should there be no appeals, a contractor is planned to be appointed.
- 3. The provincial government is responsible for the screening process and the project administrator will finalise the beneficiary list.
- 4. The current Project Steering Committee is still active and will continue to oversee the project. Should be there be a need to include new members to maintain quorum, the City will oversee the election process.
- 5. The City has been providing updates to the Ward Councillor on a regular basis. A public meeting was held in February 2016 to provide a project update to the community. A public meeting took place on 18 May 2016 to update the community on the new procurement plan.
