- Public transport traffic enforcement,
 - o issuing notices for NRTA, NLTA and Traffic Bylaw infringements
- Public transport regulations
 - impounding taxis for operating illegally or, operating contrary to their operating licences
- Revenue protection
 - o focus on issues of fair evasion on MyCiti


